THE FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD
AUGUST 6, 2023

We interrupt the normal sequence of the Sundays of Ordinary Time with the whole Church, to observe a feast which we always celebrate on August 6 every year. This year, that day falls on a Sunday. The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is so rich in meaning and importance for the ways God's saving work is manifested in our lives, that it is celebrated even when it falls on a Sunday! The transfiguration was clearly an important event in the life of the early church, because it is found in all four gospels: Mt 17, 1-8; Mk 9: 2-8, Lk 9: 28-36 and Jn 1; 1;14. Matthew's account (which we see here today in Cycle A of the Lectionary for Sunday Mass) opens our eyes to the vision of Jesus as the beloved son of the Father, as well as the Messiah.

How do we see Jesus in our own lives? All of our life is a series of manifestations of the Lord. Little by little babies... *Continued on p. 2*

Continued... become children who manifest their personality as they grow and mature. As adults, our priorities are manifested in our decisions: the way we dedicate our time and resources. Imagine watching an 8-hour long video of your day. In this video you see everything that you do, how you speak, who you help, and what you buy. This video would be a manifestation of your values and priorities.

What did Jesus teach us in his transfiguration? Shortly before this ascent to the mountain, Jesus scolds Peter when the disciple tried to deny the inevitability of his passion and death (Mt 16: 21-17). After explaining in words with each disciple he has to carry his cross, Jesus took his disciples to the mountain to see what follows after the cross: the glory of the cross in the resurrection. This is the truth for Jesus, and for us also who have been conformed to his death and resurrection in our baptism. The cross that we carry never ends in death, but in our transfiguration and resurrection. Can you remember a cross you've carried in your life that later transfigured you? Do we have to wait until our lives are over to share in this same glory of the Lord? Or, with Peter and his companions, can we receive strength and hope on the mountain with our eyes fixed on the glory of Jesus? Pray with me that the Feast of the Lord's Transfiguration will give you and I the courage we need to manifest the Lord's glory in all we say and do.

Catholic Biblical School:

Heart Knowledge that Transforms

As Catholics we hear the Bible at Mass. But there's so much more to unlock. The wisdom and experience of the Church across the centuries shows that the Sacred Scriptures are meant to be more than just something we hear. The Scriptures are meant to transform us, to become the "script" of our lives. Here's how a Catholic Biblical School ministry participant explained his journey:

"I signed up for a Catholic Biblical School class because I wanted to learn more about the Bible. I wanted to understand the history, I wanted to get some of the context, I wanted to put the pieces together. And it absolutely served that purpose. The instructors are all wonderful, they are all very very educated and knowledgeable, very good teachers...But, what I didn't expect and wasn't even asking or looking for—that came in two ways. First, the Mass is much more meaningful. The Old Testament reading, the Psalm, and the New Testament, now it's all connected for me. Now I really want to go [to Mass]...I never really felt like I "had" to go before, but now I really want to go, I want to participate and get the fullness out of Mass.

[And secondly] I feel like I have a personal relationship with God. And I don't think I ever had that. I didn't even know to ask for it. I'd heard people say it—and I'd say 'yeah, yeah, I probably do,' but I don't think I did'.

Now getting up in the morning and reading the Bible, it's like brushing my teeth and combing my hair...if I don't do it, I feel like I left something out. It's a part of my life, and I didn't expect that. Everyone in our class got things out of it they didn't even know they should ask for!"

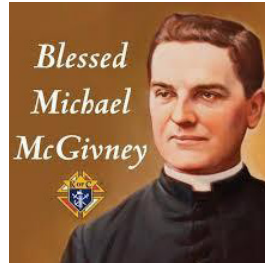


Knights of Columbus Feast Day for Michael McGivney

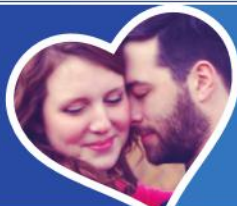
