ne of the most neglected elements of worship in many parishes is silence. Concern for active participation by the people and vibrant worship leads some parishes to overlook the importance of silence. Sometimes we worship with one eye on the clock, forgetting that our minds and hearts can truly rest in the Lord on the first day of the week. Resting without checking our watches may indeed be the rest we need!

Today's first reading from 1 Kings tells us that God is often found in the still, quiet moment, in silence. ... *Continued on p. 2*

Continued... The Roman Missal, which guides our prayer during mass stresses the importance of silence at various points throughout the liturgy. Each time the presider invites the assembly to pray ("Let us pray"), there should be time for silent prayer before the collect is prayer aloud. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, speaking of the opening prayer, says, "The priest invites the people to pray and together with him they observe a brief silence so that they may realize they "are in God's presence and may call their petitions to mind" (no. 32).

The Introduction to the Lectionary speaks eloquently about the importance of silence. "The liturgy of the word must be celebrated in a way that fosters meditation; clearly any sort of haste that hinders reflectiveness must be avoided. The dialogue between God and his people taking place through the Holy Spirit demands short intervals of silence, suited to the assembly, as an opportunity to take the word of God to heart and to prepare a response to it in prayer. Proper times for silence during the liturgy of the word are, for example, before this liturgy begins after the first and the second reading, after the homily (no. 28).

The Roman Missal teaches us that our song, while all receive the Eucharist, is a sign and sacrament of our oneness in the Lord, until all have shared in the Body and the Blood of the Lord. It also encourages a time or silence after all have received communion. Although an option is given for "a hymn, psalm, or other song of praise...sung by the entire congregation," there is no mention here of a "meditation song by the choir or a soloist.

Of course, if we lack silence during the week, we may be less likely to enter fully into silence during the liturgy. If you and I lack some quiet time for reflection and prayer during the week, we are missing an opportunity to know the Lord better as he walks with us everyday. It might help to set aside our phones for a while.

There is definitely a time for noise at mass! There are dialogues between Christ and his people, there are songs raised up in praise and thanksgiving, there are petitions which arise from our hearts and there is the noise of the people of God standing, sitting and kneeling. We can rejoice in the noise we make, and in the silence which helps us to encounter the mystery of Gods presence with us at Mass!




