27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
OCTOBER 8, 2023

The 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, the official name of what is commonly referred to as the Synod on synodality, promises to be decisive for the future of the Catholic Church.

A Synod is a gathering of the Church focused on discernment through listening. The Second Vatican Council called for the Bishops to gather in Synod with the Holy Father. Pope Francis has expanded that vision to include lay men and women this October's Synod in Rome. The Synod of Bishops is now referred simply as "the Synod!" 365 Synod Fathers and Mothers who will meet in Paul VI Hall in the Vatican for what is actually only the first session of this

ordinary general assembly. The second session is to take place next year, in October 2024.

The work of this initial session will be divided into four parts this October. First, synodality (the assembly's central theme), then the second week of work will be devoted to the theme of communion, and finally the notion of co-responsibility for mission, followed by that of governance.

These four themes will include an introduction by the Synod assembly's general rapporteur, Jesuit Cardinal Jean-Claude Hollerich of Luxembourg. Then participants will break into small language groups for two half-day sessions with the ... *Continued on p. 2*

Continued... help of facilitators, often theologians who will help guide the discussion. These discussions will continue as the groups dialogue with each other, and pray together.

The group discussions will be followed by four plenary sessions, which Pope Francis is expected to attend, combining reports on the group discussions with free contributions. It is assumed that all these discussions will be confidential to avoid grandstanding and allow all involved to speak freely.

There are also some new features at this 16th ordinary general assembly. For instance, all members of the Synod assembly will have taken part in a three-day retreat before the work begins. They are also scheduled to make an October 12 pilgrimage to one of Rome's Christian catacombs. And on the 19th, they will join in a prayer for migrants and refugees in St. Peter's Square.

Please keep the members of the Synod in your prayers during the month of October.

Who will be taking part in this assembly?

For the first time in the history of the Church, 54 women will be full members of the Synod with voting rights. This is considered something of a revolution and is, in any case, a powerful symbol, particularly in view of the 62 cardinals present.

Mary, the First Disciple?

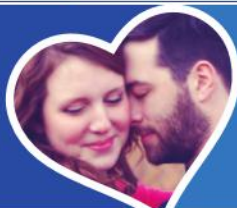
