"Show Me the Money!

Is Jesus' request of the religious authorities who confront him about paying taxes, which is really a question about his allegiance to the Roman Emperor. The coinage in question here bore the image of the Roman Emperor, who was called a god. As a graven image of a false god, it was a violation of the second commandment. There were money changers in the Temple precincts because offensive Roman coins had to be exchanged for Temple shekels that would be used to purchase lambs for sacrifice and to make the offering that was mandatory for Jewish males each year. Jesus' response is a very sharp reminder that there is a huge gap between the dominion of Caesar and the dominion of heaven, and no one can serve two masters. One god instigates the suffering and death of Jesus, while the true God achieves the real victory - new life, resurrection. ... Continued on p. 2




Continued... What conflicts with civil authorities do Christians face now? How? Why? What modern structures now occupy the place of Caesar and his empire? Have politics changed much? What do you think of people who refuse to pay taxes because their ethical standards conflict with civil authority? Do people sometimes align themselves with politicians purely for their own self-interest?

Many people misunderstand Jesus' teaching about Caesar and God. They think that it means that religion and politics or religion and economics "don't mix." The Second Vatican Council taught that such thinking "deserves to be counted among the most serious errors of our age." Gaudium et Spes, #43. How we make and spend money and how we act (or refuse to act) politically expresses much about where our allegiance lies. The divisions evident, even today, in our legislative bodies may invite us to question whether our responsibility is to hold on to power, in any way shape or form, or to work together for the common good.




