30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME  
OCTOBER 29, 2023

Sometimes it helps when someone explains things to us gradually, one step at a time.

For people like me, whose minds tend to race a little sometimes, slowing down and listening to a story, or taking the time to share some information in detail is good practice!

Jesus does just that in the gospel today when he is asked about the greatest commandment. He 'breaks it down' for us. But in doing so, he uncovers the real challenge behind it: that we must reflect the radically inclusive love of God in all we do, especially as members of Christ's Body, the Church.

In response to a query about the greatest of the many commandments the people of the Covenant held dear, Jesus responds: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

We can imagine the crowd listening to Jesus and nodding in approval. But Jesus continues to surprise them, and us. He says the second commandment "is like" this "greatest and first commandment." It is the commandment to "love your neighbor as yourself." ...*Continued on p. 2*

*Continued...* Jesus takes God's words to the Israelites — "You shall not wrong any widow or orphan" — and helps us to see that an offense against the poor and helpless is an offense against God.

Who is this God, concerned that the neighbor who has given his only cloak as collateral for a loan has nothing else for cover in the cold? Who is this God, linking our welcome of the alien with our duty of love to Him? Who is this God, bending down from heaven to hear the cry of the oppressed and the molested? This is God the Father revealed in Christ Jesus the Son, who says, "The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments." Does this look and sound like the God we claim as our own? Does this correspond to the image of God we had in our childhood? Does this love of God allow us to segregate, alienate or push the non-believer, or the sinner away?

Jesus links love of God with love of neighbor in such a way that the two commandments cannot be severed. Love of neighbor that is not rooted in love of God will find roots in something less, often in the desire that the rescued worship the rescuer. And love of God that does not manifest in love of neighbor will manifest in empty rites, untethered to the world God made and tends and acts to save. Love God. Love Neighbor. It is as simple, and profound, and challenging as that!

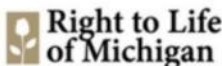
