Where do you find peace?

Something I love about Scripture is that at times, some of the shortest passages have the greatest meaning. Psalm 131 is a shorter Psalm and is in the Liturgy of the Word this weekend. "In you, Lord, I have found my peace." We find peace in the Lord. In this time when war is taking a world stage in the Middle East, Ukraine, and elsewhere, we pray for peace, which only God can provide. As the Psalm continues, it is really a Psalm of trust. As a child rests on his mother's lap, so my soul within me. Having childlike trust is what God calls us to, knowing all well God is always there and ready to open the door of peace to those who ask.

Our second reading this weekend (1 Thessalonians 2:7b-9, 13) gives us the basis for our trust in what is proclaimed to us in these Scriptures: "In receiving the word of God from hearing us, you received not a human word but, as it truly is, the word of God, which is now at work in you who believe". As we receive God's word this day, let us open our hearts and minds to what God wishes to reveal to us and how we can respond with childlike faith and trust.
