Go Make of All Disciples

Will you pray for your parish staff this week?

This Thursday, November 30, the staffs of our parishes in the family will be gathering at St. Cyprian for a half day gathering to break open and finalize missionary strategic plans in our family of parishes. The Archdiocese of Detroit has asked each family to create these plans. Why? So we can collaborate in mission oriented activities to unleash the gospel beyond the walls of our parishes. For example, reaching out to young families for children and family programming is a priority. We can no longer sit at our desks and wait for people to sign up for things anymore. We need to go out where the people are. This means most importantly equipping every person in our parishes to be a minister of hospitality and welcome.

We will be gathering for morning Mass on November 30 at 9 am at St. Cyprian. Please feel welcome to join us, pray with and for us and for the whole Church. November 30 is the Feast of St. Andrew, an apostle of Jesus. The Gospel this day (Matthew 4:18-22) recalls Jesus walking along the sea watching Peter and his brother Andrew casting nets into the sea. This is what we're about - we must be fishers of all people, meaning we have to go out to proclaim the message of Jesus,

invite, and bring people in! I was recently meeting with Deacon Steve Mitchell and we were reflecting on some of this. He recalled a quote relating to this - "Are we keepers of the aquarium or are we fishers of men?" Are we going to simply manage what we have and not worry about those who are not part of who we are, or are we going to immediately respond to the words of Jesus and follow him?






RCIA RCIA Candidate





Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Friday, December 8

Mass celebrated at noon, Sacred Heart Church

The Immaculate Conception means that Mary from the first moment of her existence was totally free from the influence of that universal sinfulness which touches us all from the time we are born. The reason behind this belief (which is not explicitly contained in Scripture and was only infallibly defined in 1854,) is that only a sinless environment was fitting for the Son of God in his becoming a human being. It has a very long history in the Church.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (490-491) states:

To become the mother of the Savior, Mary was enriched by God with gifts appropriate to such a role. The angel Gabriel at the moment of the annunciation salutes her as "full of grace." In fact, in order for Mary to be able to give the free assent of her faith to the announcement of her vocation, it was necessary that she be wholly borne by God's grace.

Through the centuries the Church has become more and more aware that Mary, "full of grace" through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception. That is what the dogma of the Immaculate Conception states, as Pope Pius IX proclaimed in 1854. "The most blessed Virgin Mary was from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin."

We will discuss the four basic dogmas the Church teaches about Mary and what Catholics really mean when they say they "pray" to Mary and the saints, and what role Mary should play in the life of every believer.


