1ST SUNDAY OF LENT
FEBRUARY 18, 2024

"Turn away from sin and believe the Gospel"

These words are among those used when we began Lent with ashes on our foreheads. From the beginning Lent is a time for looking inward into our hearts, and searching for God's mercy there, and a time for looking outward, to see if the Gospel is truly being manifested in the world because of our actions. Jesus' call to "repentance" is much more than simply acknowledging this or that sin. It is really a matter of changing our minds and hearts. When we give something up for Lent, we ought to consider turning away from some way of being that has taken control of us, captivating our daily lives, flooding us, drawing us ever more tightly into the less important. Such turning is likely hard, but the goal is not self-improvement through willpower. Our fasting during Lent is not a quick weight loss program! The goal is reached through the other part: trusting. It comes from recalling the story of God's promise after the flood, and really believing that the news God brings is good. It is not about me as an individual becoming a better person (although let's hope that happens!); It's about opening myself in trust to the signs of what God is doing in me, but even more importantly, in the world.

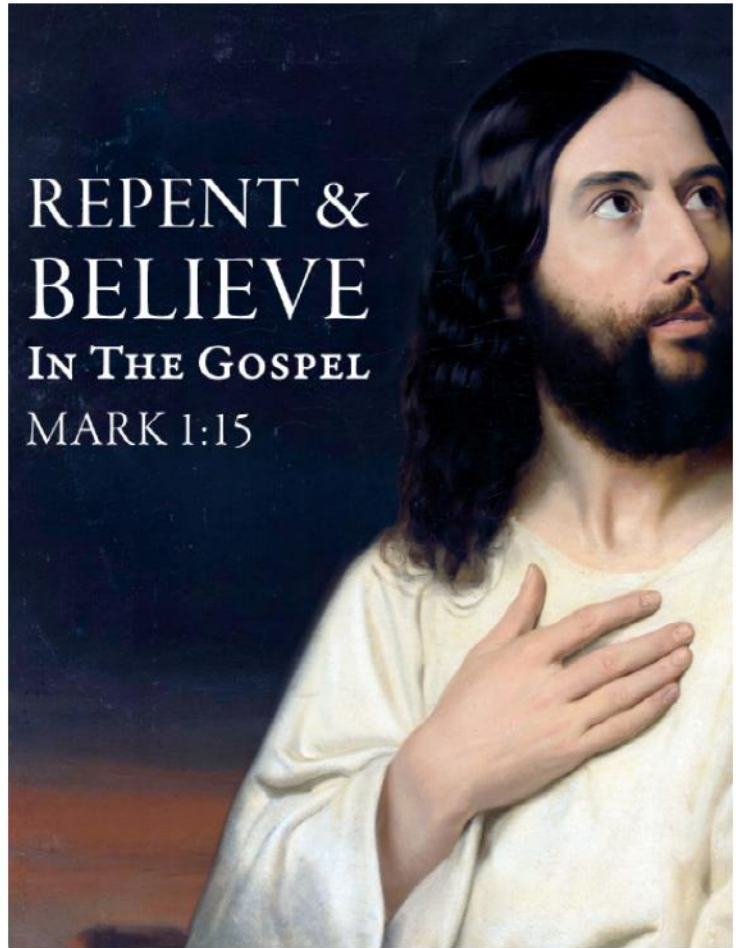

1. Take the cross of the way in your home, and put it on a table, on a pillow or a cloth, for all to see and reflect upon.
 2. Consider daily mass as a Lenten practice, if only one or two days a week.
 3. Plan your Lent accordingly, setting aside time for reflection on scripture, especially the Sunday Mass readings.
 4. "Clear the decks" now for Holy Week and make participating in these most beautiful days a priority for you and your family.
 5. Include service in your Lenten discipline: visit a soup kitchen, or the homebound, and increase your awareness of the needs of others.
 6. Take an inventory of how much time and attention to give social media. Are we allowing others to shape our view of the world, or do we find what we need in Scripture and tradition, which is ever ancient and new at the same time.
 7. Pray for our Candidates and our Elect who will be initiated at the Vigil. What would it be like for you to make the same journey to the font and the table at this time in your life?
 8. Post about your Lenten discipline on Social Media! Don't be shy about your faith.
 9. Make sure your Lent is about three important spiritual acts: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.
 10. Take time out meet new friends and old at ones of our parish fish fry's.
 11. Call the parish and find out the anniversary date of your baptism. Celebrate with a dinner for friends!
- May this Lenten season enliven the hope of salvation in all our hearts.

Lent is a wonderful time of grace for Catholic Christians to experience inner change of heart and mind through the gift of conversion and repentance. This presentation, led by **Sister Helen Therese**, is an opportunity for your personal renewal during the holy season of Lent. Saint Pope Paul II wrote a letter about reconciliation and penance in which he tells us why we need to develop our sense of sin and our need for the graces of individual confession. An adequate self-knowledge inescapably includes the recognition of "oneself as being a sinner capable of sin and inclined to commit sin." (1 John 1:8-9) Such self-knowledge is the "essential first step in returning to God: there is no conversion without the acknowledgement of one's own sin."

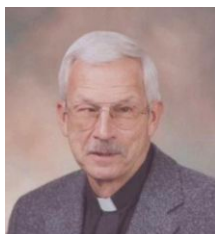
