Go Make of All Disciples

Do you like drama?

No other celebration in the life of the Church has more drama than Palm Sunday. The way we celebrate these liturgies help us unfold the drama and tell the story. This is the story of stories - the Passion of our Lord. In the Palm Sunday liturgy, we go from waving palm branches and hearing of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. When we sing Hosanna, that is the same Hosanna we sing at the beginning of the Eucharistic prayer every Mass. We praise God because Jesus is about to be made present to us. The people in Jerusalem praised God because the Messiah, the Anointed One, has arrived.

What begins with songs of triumph on Palm Sunday, however, quickly shifts into remembrance of our Lord's passion. That royal entry into the holy city of Jerusalem was also an entrance into the mystery of his suffering, death, and resurrection. Jesus knew fully what he was walking into. Palm Sunday starts off Holy Week for us. This week is different than the other 51 weeks of the year. Therefore, I encourage you to make it different for yourselves as well. These events we celebrate during Holy Week, beginning with Palm Sunday and culminating with the Easter Vigil are not just recollections of past events, but making present here and now these realities that Jesus suffered, died, and rose. So, what can you do differently this week?

- 1. Set aside extra time for prayer and reflection
- 2. Go to the daily Masses that are offered in our Family of Parishes this week
- 3. Participate in some or all of the days of the Paschal Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil/Sunday
- 4. Fast from food or other activities that will allow you to spend more time with Jesus in these days






