In addition to Sundays, Easter repeats itself whenever a loved one dies, because even as we grieve our hearts remind us of the hope of the resurrection we experience each year. We need that hope in our lives. The death of a relationship, the loss of a job, moving to a home are also experiences of loss in our lives that cause us to move from sadness and despair to joy and hope in the new life Christ offers us even in moments of change in our lives.

Easter repeats itself in the sacraments, as married couples rise to new life by loving and forgiving each other, the sick rise beyond despair as they are anointed with the oil of the sick. Priests are ordained to be the sacrament of Christ the Servant. We are washed in baptism, anointed in confirmation and sustained by the Eucharist. This journey is recapitulated and renewed in the sacrament of reconciliation.

Easter repeats itself in creation as the world around us blooms and grows again, and we are reminded of the sacrifices necessary to preserve the marvelous gift of creation for generations to come.

Easter repeats itself for me through every one of you. Through your strong faith, exercised in humble service, you constantly remind me that the Risen Lord remains in the world in and through his imperfect but redeemed body, the Church.

As often as sin and death return to frustrate us and distract us, recall that the events of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. They are constantly made present to us again along with their saving power through the Risen Lord. Sin and death repeat themselves, but Easter's Risen Lord always has the last word! May your Easter fill you and your loved ones with hope.







## Happy March!




