... *Continued* The jubilant psalm we sing today is the song of the sheep who rejoice in their saving Shepherd. As we continue to hear from Peter's sermon in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 4: 8-12), Peter echoes this psalm and attributes the healing of a crippled man not to his own glory, but to the only one who saves us: Jesus the Christ.

The good shepherd gathers us for this time of worship, much like the shepherd gathers the sheep in a verdant pasture of rest and refreshment. God cares for us knowingly, freely, faithfully. As we return from this place to the flocks for whom we care, may our gratitude for this shepherding become for us and them yet one more Easter grace. Knowing, intimacy, familiar, connected Free, no strings attached, willing and wanting to care Faithful, staying with rather than trying to take away from. We endeavor to do the same for one another, in memory of Jesus. The difference between ourselves and real lambs is that they do not get up and begin to pasture each other. We do. That is why we celebrate First Eucharist masses with such joy and hope. Whether or not you have a child or a grandchild celebrating with you this year, take some time to reflect on the day of your first Eucharist. Chances are the people you celebrated with that day had made sharing their faith with you a priority. Think about how they went about helping you to know Jesus the Good Shepherd better. Don't be afraid to share your memories with family, friends, and on Social Media! Let's look up from our own grazing long enough to begin to pasture one another, as the Good Shepherd continues to do for us to this day.

Don't you just love the Easter Season?

The Catholic Church sure knows how to celebrate! For example, we just celebrated the "Octave of Easter" for a week after Easter Sunday. Each day is a continuation of the celebration of Easter. The Easter Season continues on for 50 days until the Solemnity of Pentecost, where Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit upon His disciples. We journey through Lent for 40 days, praying, fasting, and almsgiving. We celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead for 50 days!

So often, during the Easter Season, we celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. First and foremost, we do so at the Easter Vigil, where a number of adults in our parishes in the family were baptized and received into full communion with the Catholic Church. All of our parishes continue to experience baptism of infants, First Communions throughout the Easter Season, and Confirmation of our young people. We are Confirming young people in our Family of Parishes at St. Joseph on May 4 at the Saturday 4:30 Mass and at Our Lady of the Woods on May 19 at the 11:00 Mass. 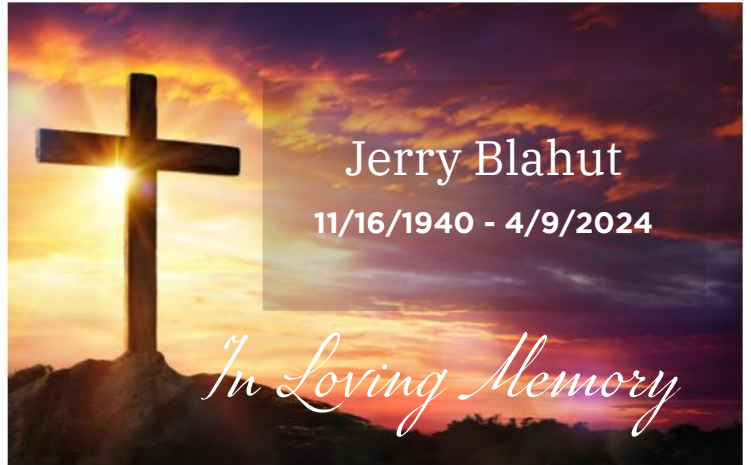
