SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
MAY 5, 2024

The nine days between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost are kept by the Church as a special time of prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit. This is what we refer to when we say we are praying a Novena for nine days. These days are the original novena days, as the texts for the prayers for the masses during these days express our sense of waiting and longing for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon us. Today's liturgy falls in this period, and its readings especially highlight the Spirit's power in the Church's life. The spirit inspires the choice of Matthias to replace Judas in the first reading. The second reading points to the Holy Spirit as the source of Christ's abiding presence with believers, which joins them as one in the love of God and one another.

... *Continued* Our oneness with Christ in the Spirit, the Gospel points out, puts us in an odd relationship with the world. In baptism we have been “consecrated”, set aside for God’s service, and so we might not be shocked to experience the same rejection Christ, (the cornerstone) rejected by the builders, which has become the cornerstone [Ps. 118:22]) received. Christ’s abiding presence, however, gives us hope and spurs us on in the knowledge that the glory God has given Christ “will be accomplished in the body of the whole Church” (Prayer after Communion).

Our Spiritual Mother and the Community of Saints

Jesus gave his mother to us as our spiritual mother, and she intercedes for us in heaven before her Son. By growing in relationship with Mary and the rest of the saints, we grow in fellowship with Jesus.

Jesus was “born of the Virgin Mary” and is the Mother of God, Queen of Heaven, and the first most perfect disciple of the Lord. We are going to learn in this session just who Mary is and why loving Mary brings us closer to her son, Jesus.

We will look at:

- The four basic dogmas that the Church teaches about Mary

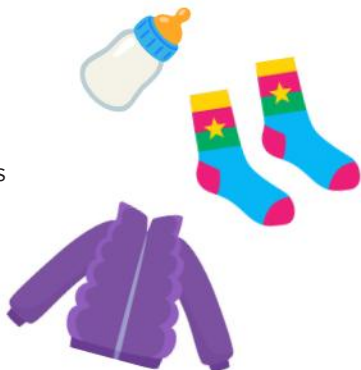

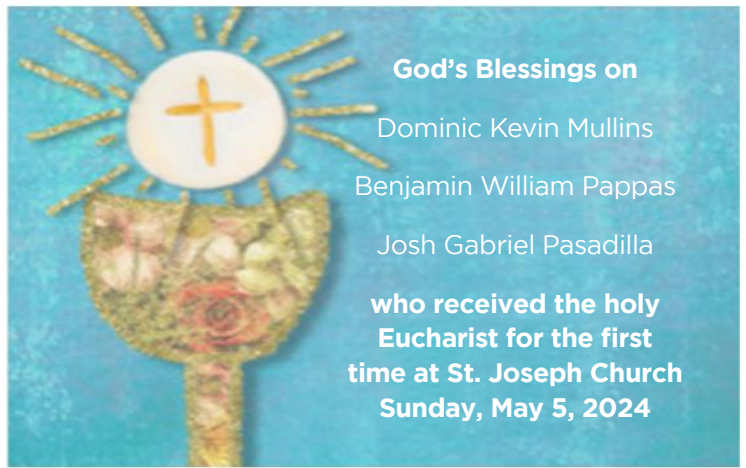
