The Lectionary gives us two different accounts of the pouring out of the Spirit upon the Disciples. In the Acts of the Apostles, the story of the Pentecost event is recounted by Luke and the beautiful encounter between the risen Christ and his frightened disciples from the Fourth Gospel is proclaimed today as well. Both accounts are true. They present different facets of the same joy-filled event that Pentecost was, unifying the apostles and the whole world in the call to respond with joy to the Gospel.

Pentecost continues in our lives. Every time we enter Church we really experience the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon ourselves in Baptism. The Holy Spirit draws us together as we listen to God's word and the Risen Jesus unites us to one another and comforts our frightened hearts with his Eucharistic presence.

As the sun shines, and we plant flowers and continue to celebrate weddings and graduations, listen closely to the voice of the Holy Spirit speaking to you and to the whole church. What is the Spirit saying? God gives what we need to do his will. Are we ready to follow?

Next week we will bless married couples as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. The following week our Corpus Christi processions will publicly manifest our faith in the Eucharistic presence of the Lord, through the power of the Holy Spirit. A reminder that the feast of Corpus Christi also inaugurates our 5 PM Sunday evening Mass on the Detroit river on Grosse Ile, at the corner of Church St. and E. River Rd. Whenever the weather is too hot or humid or rainy, we hold that mass in the air conditioned St. Anne Chapel. Come and join us!

You may have already received an invitation to support the Catholic Service Appeal. Please remember that supporting the CSA also means supporting your parish as each parish must make its goal every year. Pray about your gift, and pledge soon! I'm grateful for all your generous support!

The Spring also brings renewal in our parishes, which is evident through the Spirit filled work of our parishioners. # Go Make of All Disciples

#### Do you know what it's like to grieve?

Everyone grieves differently and for different reasons - loss of a job, loss of a child, loss of a spouse, or a friend. One way or the other, it comes down to a loss. Everyone also responds differently to those moments.

Some like to be in a group, some need time alone or just try to move

past the grief like nothing ever happened. Whichever way someone moves through stages of grief, our community of faith must stand beside them.

Our Family of Parishes is adopting a ministry called, "Stephen Ministry." A few of us staff people from our Family of Parishes are currently participating in training to form this ministry. This includes recruiting "Stephen Ministers." But how could I help people through their grief? I'm not a counselor or therapist! This isn't about therapy or counseling, but about accompanying our brothers and sisters in whatever sort of grief is taking over their lives. Just as our new Coordinator of Youth Ministry is looking for adult and teen leaders from each of our parishes, I am looking for people who may be interested in this ministry, being Christ's hands of welcome and care for those who are grieving. More formal ways of recruitment will come as the summer progresses, but I want you to pray about how God can use you.

In Archbishop Vigneron's Pastoral Letter, "Unleash the Gospel," he calls for "no bystanders." Each member of the Body of Christ brings spiritual gifts that another does not have. "The engagement of every person according to their gifts and state of life, is essential for the mission of the Church to be fulfilled" (UTG, Guidepost 5). This most importantly speaks to our second reading today. St. Paul reminds us that there are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord (1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13). Pray about your gifts and how you can continue to build up the Body of Christ!


