Have you ever considered the power of the sign of the cross? I often wonder if, as often I sign my body with the sign of my own redemption, I don't sometimes take it for granted. How can we take the sign of the cross for granted? It's with us from the very beginning until the very end of our lives. One of the most beautiful moments in the rite for Infant Baptism is when the parents and godparents wordlessly sign the sign of the cross on the forehead of their child as they are "claimed" for Christ. Like so many powerful gestures, this happens in silence because the gesture so powerfully speaks for itself at the beginning of our Christian lives... *Continued on p. 2*

We then learn how to cross ourselves, as our parents and grandparents tutor us by their own example. We gradually learn what it means to be included among the members of Christ's Risen Body, his Church as we celebrate the Eucharist and share our first Eucharist. Our faith in the power of the cross deepens as we mature and grow older, and the same forehead marked tenderly by the hands of our parents at baptism is now signed with Chrism by the Bishop at Confirmation. Rings are blessed by the sign of the cross at our weddings, and our foreheads are signed with the cross with the oil of the sick, reminding us how much we need the Lord. Finally, at the end of our lives, in the same doorway that welcomed us in the arms of our parents, our bodies, now spent, are honored with the water of baptism and clothed once more in a white garment. Throughout our lives, the cross goes before us, is borne in our hands and becomes our strength, even in suffering.

This is the cross of the Trinity. We do all that we do in the name of the one who saves us.

Plan on joining us for the celebration of Corpus Christi, next weekend including the processions that may follow the mass.

Go Make of All Disciples

Are you hungry?

Next Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At a recent First Communion, Fr. Gary Morelli was talking about the size of the host we receive when we receive the Eucharist. He said the reason it is so small is that we will always want to come back for more. When we eat dinner, we eat a plate of food and it fills us up. The Eucharist, however, does not fill our stomachs so we have that sense of being full after a meal, but it fills our hearts and feeds our souls. This way, we desire to receive the Eucharist in a more regular way to keep filling us up!

Another way we can quench our hunger and thirst is by chewing on the Word of God. Christ is present in the proclamation of the Word just as He is present in the Blessed Sacrament. I leave you with the responsorial Psalm refrain we'll pray together next weekend:

I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord. Psalm 116

QDC

QCDs, Qualified Charitable Distributions, are among the best-kept secrets for senior IRA account owners. A QCD directly transfers funds from your retirement account to a qualified charity, like St. Cyprian or the AOD CSA program. In addition to the benefits of giving to charity, a QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA.

The secret is that QCDs count toward your Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) if you are 73 or older. Also, QCDs don't require that you itemize, which, due to changes in the 2017 tax law, means you may decide to take advantage of the higher standard deduction but still use a QCD for charitable giving.

Talk to your tax preparer and IRA custodian for more information. And consider sharing your tax savings with us.
