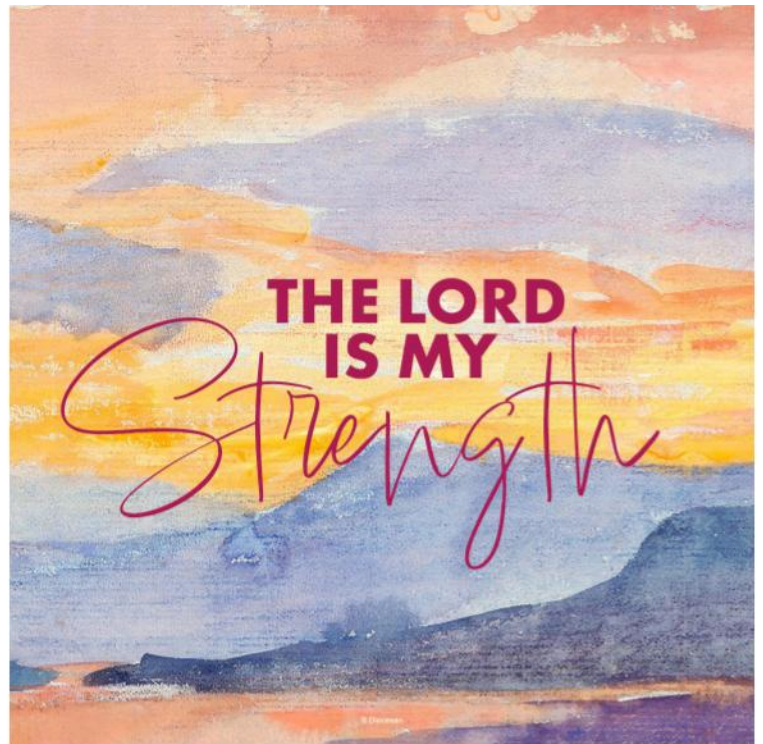

Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven

This passage from Matthew 18:4 reminds us of the importance of a childlike faith. What does it mean to have faith like a child? This is not as much the innocence of a child, but it shows a complete dependence and trust in their parents. So we as disciples must be in complete dependence and trust in God. Watching so many little children from parishes around our Family of Parishes join last week at Sacred Heart for Vacation Bible School, I was inspired. Watching their complete openness to Jesus and His teachings, they really expressed their childlike faith.

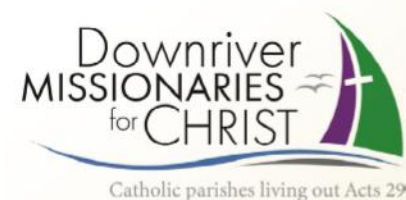
I say this as an example to all of us to allow yourself to live in that complete dependence and trust in God, just as these children did at VBS. That doesn't mean we won't ever wrestle with some aspects of our faith or struggle with believing at times. God will speak to you in prayer, and the faith community will be around you to support you.

This is a tough statement to hear at times; however, it is also a great reminder to us to not just listen to God's word but truly let that word permeate our hearts and our minds. Qualified Charitable Contributions (QCDs)

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a tax-free withdrawal from an Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made directly to a qualifying charity like Sacred Heart or the AOD CSA Program. It is available to you whether you take the higher standard deduction or itemize, serving as a popular way to do good while also satisfying the IRA holder's required minimum distribution (RMD) if certain requirements are met.

If you do itemize, the QCD is not eligible for a charitable deduction, but is not included in the IRA owner's adjusted gross income (AGI). Leveraging a QCD to lower one's AGI could potentially reduce taxes and those surcharges based on income, such as Social Security benefits or Medicare Parts B and D premiums. Available to owners and beneficiaries age 70 or older, a QCD offers tax-free IRA distributions of up to \$105,000 in 2024.

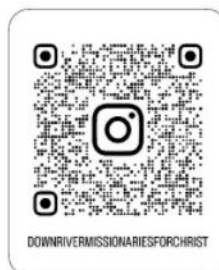
