17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
JULY 28, 2024

The Second Vatican Council ended in 1964, but I am fond of reminding people that the real work began as the Bishops of the world traveled home from the Council. Priests and theologians were appointed by Pope Paul VI to carry out the challenging reforms the Council called for. One of these is the Lectionary for Mass, the collection of readings from Scripture proclaimed on Sunday. These readings have been chosen from what been called “the heart of the Bible.” As a result, we have a richer banquet of God’s word to feast on every Sunday. There are three cycles, over the course of three years, which enable us to hear more of the scriptures proclaimed at Mass. This year we have been listening to the scriptures of Cycle B which most frequently include the Gospel of Mark. However, every year we listen to a portion of the Gospel of John in the Summer. This week begins that proclamation which continues until August 22, the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time. This becomes, for us, an extended reflection on the 6th chapter of John’s gospel, which contains what is known as “the Bread of Life discourse.” ... *Continued on p. 2*

The multiplication of loaves by Jesus, (John 6: 1-15) recalls the multiplication of loaves by Elisha (2 Kings 4: 42-44) These are stories of abundance and “left-overs” in a time and place when most of us have enough to eat. We may not be able to go out as often as we might like, we may have to clip coupons or cut corners, but we eat. Quite a different situation from other parts of the world. Just recall Rwanda, where this very moment, many people are dying for lack of food. Here families eat. There they starve. Many of us help the hungry through organizations like Food for the Poor (foodforthe poor.org) or Bread for the World. (bread.org)

We are not wrong for having food. We do not need to feel guilty about having enough to eat, unless we have eaten so much and for so long, that we have forgotten what it like to be hungry. Sometimes we forget, however, that God is the giver of all good gifts, and that we are always called to respond to gratitude to God. We cannot rely just on ourselves what we need to survive. We rely on God first.

The people fed in the gospel wanted more. Their faith was based more on the food, then on the feeder. They wanted the bread, but not the baker. So, Jesus left them, until they were ready to hear his message, he would try again.

This summer, as you gather to eat with family and friends, don't be afraid to remind people to thank God for the food you are about to share. Remember the hungry when you do. Invite others to name what they are grateful to God for in the process. We can remember that all good gifts which feed us come from the God who loves us abundantly and has blessed us abundantly.

Go Make of All Disciples

Would you comfort Martha and Mary?

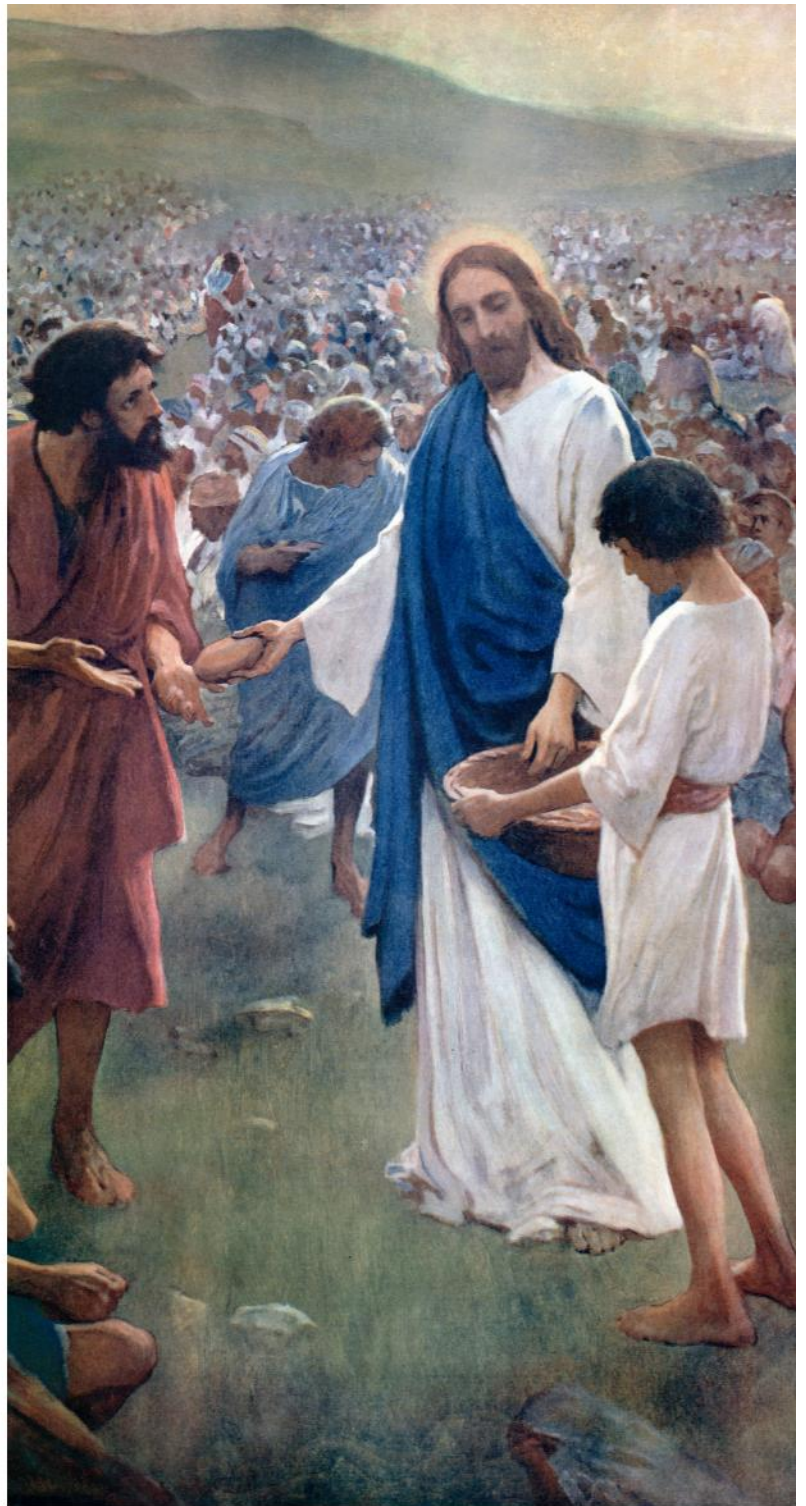
This Monday, July 29, the Church celebrates the Memorial of Sts. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. One of the options of the Gospel for Mass this day is the story of the raising of Lazarus (John 11:19-27). The Jewish people went to comfort Martha and Mary in their grief. That is what Stephen Ministry is all about, comforting people in their grief. Just as Jesus comforted Martha and Mary with the words, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and anyone who lives and believes in me will never die." Feast days like this, give us the opportunity to reflect on the same - can we join Martha in saying, "I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." To comfort someone else in grief and loss means to reflect in our own lives what happens when people die.

As Stephen Ministry gives people a time and a place to offer that reflection, as well as process through any grief people are struggling with, allowing for space for this ministry is imperative. This space is for those who can minister to others, or for those who need Stephen Ministry. Another option for a Gospel for this feast day is Luke 10:38-42. Jesus was welcomed by Martha and Mary, while Martha was busy about other things while Mary sat with Jesus listening to him speak. Jesus reminded Martha not to be anxious or worried, as Mary has chosen the better part. As we sit with people in their grief, we are sitting with Jesus. Let us both be the presence of Jesus to those who are struggling as well as recognize Jesus in those people.

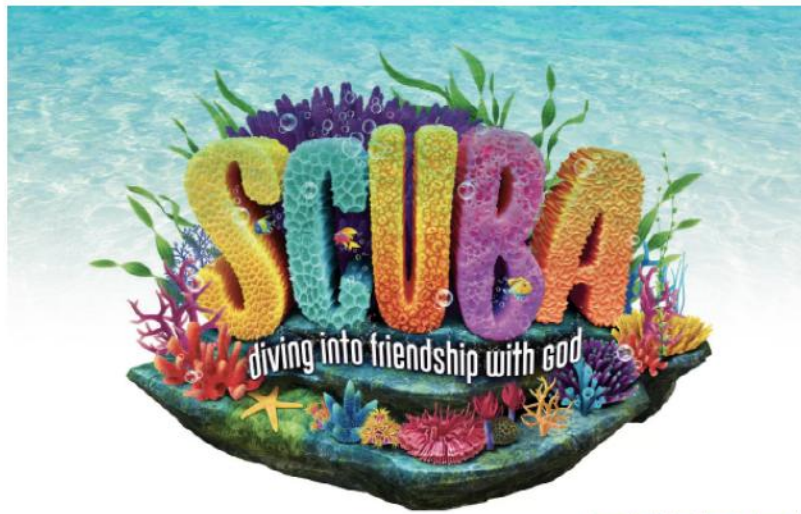
