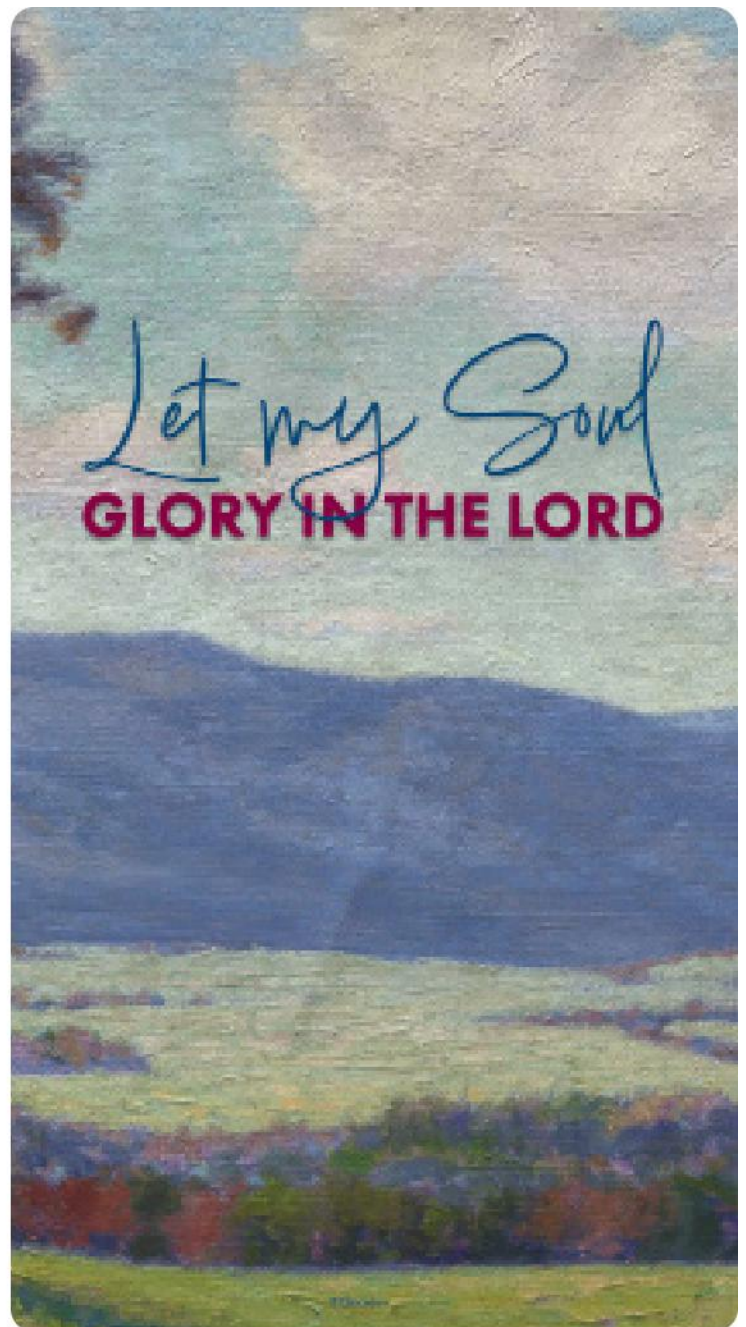
Why is it so important that Mary's body is in heaven?

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary this Thursday, August 15 (there are a number of Masses in our Family of Parishes for this Holy Day of Obligation), we profess that Mary's body and soul was assumed into heaven. This is different than the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. Because Mary was the living tabernacle of Jesus' earthly presence, there was no way God could have allowed her to be with sin nor could her body be corrupted by death. Do you know we become tabernacles as well? Cardinal Tagle in his homily during the recent Eucharistic Congress shared how there were 60,000 tabernacles in the arena at the moment. That is a powerful concept. Like Mary, when Jesus is inside of us, we become tabernacles. Just as Mary brought Christ into the world, so we bring Christ into the world through our Eucharistic presence. The only difference is we were not born without the stain of original sin and the capacity to sin. Let us be ever aware of our own need of conversion as we move to convert the world!
