



Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

The **RCIA** is the process by which people become members of the Catholic Church. Also known as the Catechumenate, it is a Journey of Faith, a process of growth and conversion that takes place through the proclamation of the Gospel, teaching of Catholic doctrine, and a gradual introduction to the customs and practices of Catholic life.

This gradual development culminates in the celebration of the initiation of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist at Easter. **The Rite is designed for:**

- Those seeking Baptism, that is, those not baptized previously in another Christian denomination
- Any non-Catholic baptized in a Christian denomination and would like to learn about the Roman Catholic faith
- Any baptized Catholic, not raised in the faith, but now seeks to become a practicing Catholic
