You don't need a theology degree to bring people to the Lord. You just simply have to tell people the impact your faith has had on your life. And that is done through the witness of the Gospel.







### St. Cyprian Food Pantry

We, Sister Ann and Sister Margaret, feel very blessed to have the opportunity once again to be in the service of coordinating the St. Cyprian Pantry. We are grateful to Father Marc, and Patty Saenz, for their acceptance. Our history of working in the pantry dates back to the days of long ago when it was an emergency pantry under the auspices of the St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Cyprian and was coordinated by Cliff and Ruth Moening.



Life evolved and the shift was made to have a weekly pantry and part of the Christian Service ministry of St. Cyprian. During the years we were on staff, we came to know first-hand the incredible generosity of St. Cyprian parishioners in donating food and resources to purchase food as well as many volunteers who dedicated hours of work. When the pandemic hit, a decision was made to have the pantry bi-monthly, that is the first and third Wednesdays of each month. This is the current schedule. Now part of the usual distribution is frozen mean products - made possible because of the donation of several freezers.

While life has evolved over these decades, unfortunately, the number of people in need in our geographic area has not decreased. The first week of September, 56 boxes of food were distributed. There is no way that this ministry could continue without the consistent dedication of a host of volunteers - we thank you! Nor could the pantry continue without the generosity of the parishioners of St. Cyprian - we thank you in advance for your collaboration in this needed ministry to our sisters and brothers in need.

### St. Joseph's 2nd Grade

We have been learning so many new things in Second Grade so far this school year! We just finished a chapter on welcoming people into the Church in religion, and we are now learning about the sacrament of Baptism. We have done such a great job listening to the readings and what Father Marc is teaching us about each week during our school Liturgies.

In reading we have been focused on the fantasy genre. We know everything is make-believe, but it is so fun and silly to read stories about sharks going to school and cute puppies scaring an entire town! When we have center time in class, most of our activities have to do with the same theme from our weekly story. Last week we made our own sharks out of Playdoh and this week we are making cute puppies with big, googly eyes. We have also made our own shark and puppy stories and have done shark and puppy math. Whenever we have an extra few minutes in class, Mrs. Kelly reads from Freckle Juice, by Judy Blume. It's about a boy who loves freckles and will do anything to have his own. He pays a classmate to get her secret recipe for getting freckles...a disgusting mixture of ingredients he must drink to get his own freckles!

One of our favorite new activities in Second Grade is being able to independently read our own choice of books during D.E.A.R. time. Drop Everything And Read is a relaxing time in class right after lunch and recess where we can sit wherever we want around the classroom and just enjoy a good book. This time helps promote the joy of reading.

In science we have been learning about the needs of plants. We have been participating in a lab where groups of students have four plants: one plant gets full sun and water, one plant gets shade and water, one is in complete darkness and gets water, and one doesn't get any water or any light. Every two days the groups have been watering the plants that get water and measuring each plant and recording the information in a table. After a month, we will see what has happened to our plants and make a conclusion as to exactly what plants need.

We hope you have gotten an idea about what it's like to be in Second Grade at St. Joe's and have enjoyed reading this as much as we have enjoyed learning!
