One of the most influential theologians in my own life is Alexander Schemmann. He was an Orthodox theologian who wrote about liturgy and the sacraments. Writing about 'The Mystery of Love', Schemmann wrote that:

As long as we visualize marriage as the concern of those alone who are being married, as something that happens to them and not to the whole Church, and therefore to the world itself, we shall never understand the truly sacramental meaning of marriage. The great mystery to which St. Paul refers when he says: "But I speak concerning Christ and the Church." We must understand that the real theme "content" and object of his sacrament is not "family," but love. Family as such, family in itself, can be a demonic distortion of love - and there are harsh words about it in the Gospel: "...one's foes will be members of one's own household (Mt. 10:26). In this sense the sacrament of matrimony is wider than family. It is the sacrament of divine love, as the all embracing mystery of being itself; it is for this reason that it concerns the whole Church, and through the Church the whole world.

Schemmann's insight reminds us that love is founded and strengthened in family life, but that it cannot hide there. Love's true nature, which is our true nature of humans...

...created in God's image and likeness, is to extend love as a bridge and a link that spreads from marriage and family into society. The Church is a microcosm of this loving community which exists to transform the larger world. Parishes are a microcosm of the Church, and find their only mission in the extension of that love in concrete ways through prayer, teaching and service.

Parishes are sustained by the generosity of their members and the service of priests and other dedicated leaders. You may be aware of places in the world where parishes extend for miles and miles across mountain ranges and deserts. In our own country, a church founded by immigrants constructed parishes closer to each other, often to accommodate different language groups, and so we came to know the "Irish" parish or the "Polish parish." Immigrants continue to strengthen the church and its parishes with their vibrant presence and cultural expression of faith.

But our history continues to evolve, in a more highly assimilated church, with fewer priests, many dioceses are having to close and consolidate parishes. We have experienced the impact of a lack of priests in all the parishes in our family at this point. You have been asked to remember St. Timothy Parish in your prayers as a transition team, composed of members of St. Timothy Parish and pastoral leaders faced critical reductions in its parish census, and a lack of resources to address capital improvement needs. The committee recommended that the parish close and the property be sold. This recommendation was sent to the Archbishop who consulted with the Presbyteral Council before he made a decision.

On September 16, 2024, Archbishop Allen Vigneron issued two decrees concerning Saint Timothy Parish, one of which affects St. Joseph and Our Lady of the Woods Parishes.

The first decree, which addresses the merger of St. Timothy parish, causes St. Timothy Parish to cease, merging a portion of the territory (east of Allen Road) into Saint Joseph Parish, and the remainder (west of Allen Road) into Our Lady of the Woods Parish. The second decree relegates St. Timothy Church to secular but not unbecoming use." This language from Canon law means the decree decommissions the property of St. Timothy for use as a church and allows for its eventual sale.

These decisions take effect on November 25, 2024. A certified copy of the decrees may be obtained from the Moderator of the Priests In Solidum, Father Marc Gawronski by calling the St. Joseph Parish office Trenton. The decrees are posted at the entrances of the churches in our Family of Parishes. For additional

Go Make of All Disciples

Did you know that October is a month dedicated to Mary?

Mary has so many titles associated to her - for example, one of the parishes in our Family of Parishes is "Our Lady of the Woods."



What I didn't know until recently was that there is an Our Lady of the Woods in Genoa, Italy. According to tradition, Mary appeared to a young man and told him to build a temple in her honor and memory, giving him indications of what it should look like with an oak twig. The above image is at Our Lady of the Woods in Italy. There are so many images of Mary, which give us different perspectives and ways to honor her. She has always been considered the first disciple of Christ, as well as a model for all of us.

Between Mary and Jesus, there was a beautiful exchange. Saint John Paul II considered Mary a "living catechism and mother and model of all catechists." She was Jesus' first catechist, sharing Scripture with him, and formed him by her human knowledge of God's plan for the salvation of his people, her habit of daily prayer to God, and by her surrender to his will. Not only was Mary Jesus' first teacher, she was also his first disciple, or follower. Jesus formed Mary in his divine Sonship and of his obedience to the will of his heavenly Father.

Lastly, Mary is seen as the Star of Evangelization. Her appearance to St. Juan Diego in Mexico has inspired the birth of the Church throughout the Americas. Thousands were converted to the Lord through this occurrence. As the patroness of the Americas, Mary has been the beacon that has led the faithful to

encounter Jesus. We look to Mary and the saints not instead of Jesus, but as a way to be led to Jesus. 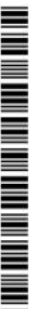
