Since our last parish assembly, when we presented the recommendation of the St. Timothy Parish Transition Team, you have been asked to remember St. Timothy Parish in your prayers as we faced critical reductions in its parish census, and a lack of resources to address capital improvement needs. The committee recommended that the parish close and the property be sold. This recommendation was sent to the Archbishop who consulted with the Presbyteral Council before he made a decision.

On September 16, 2024, Archbishop Allen Vigneron issued two decrees concerning Saint Timothy Parish, one of which affects St. Joseph and Our Lady of the Woods Parishes.

The first decree, which addresses the merger of St. Timothy parish, causes St. Timothy Parish to cease, merging a portion of the territory (east of Allen Road) into Saint Joseph Parish, and the remainder (west of Allen Road) into Our Lady of the Woods Parish. The second decree relegates St. Timothy Church to secular but not unbecoming use." This language from Canon law means the decree decommissions the property of St. Timothy for use as a church and allows for its eventual sale.


On Monday, November 4 we will hold our annual celebration of the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed at 7 PM at St. Timothy Parish.



Sacred Heart parish is offering a four-week seminar dealing with the loss of a loved one. The goal of the seminar is to reach out to others who have lost a loved one, to comfort them, to console them, and to listen to them. On your journey we want to offer you hope.

Life is no longer what it was - it is different. No one will take the place of the one who has died. In time you will remember your loved one warmly with memories that will bring a smile to your face.

We would like to cultivate spiritual and emotional healing from your loss. We will do this by covering the Ten Stages of Grief. Studies have been done to try to learn how loss affects us and how we react to grief through the various stages.
