I want to see! I can hear Bartimaeus' voice, crying out the moment he becomes aware that it's Jesus of Nazareth who's causing the commotion along the road. And he calls Jesus "Son of David," which is a messianic title — he is making a claim even Jesus didn't make for himself in public. People try to stop the blind man, but he doesn't relent. Jesus is impressed enough to stop. This is in Mark's gospel, mind you, where Jesus never stops. And Jesus says, "Call him." He called me; now call him.

"Jesus is calling you!" the disciples say, "Take courage." Courage is about all Bartimaeus has, that and a cloak to collect alms. He throws aside the cloak, along with any fear and with his desperate past. For a sightless man, he moves fast, springing up and coming to Jesus. What do you want me to do for you?" he asks simply. Just as directly, Bartimaeus replies, "Master, I want to see."

In the familiar Marcan refrain, we already know his faith has saved him. Jesus adds, "Go your way," but Bartimaeus is more interested in going His way: the way Jesus is going.

... He follows Jesus. We don't have to wonder if he became a disciple. Bartimaeus follows Jesus even though Jesus is striding directly toward Jerusalem where he will meet the cross. I imagine the newly sighted disciple Bartimaeus following close behind Jesus, pushing past Peter, James and John, who look on with amazement. The only one who can truly see where Jesus is going is Bartimaeus.

Frequently Jesus most faithful followers including you and I, need to see what they have not yet seen, and learn from people we assume have been blind for so long. This is a case of the blind leading the sighted! From the beginning Bartimaeus recognized Jesus from his place in the dark on the side of the road; crying out to the "Son of David", the messiah, for healing. What can Bartimaeus teach us? What blindness needs healing on our way to Jerusalem, and the cross?


To live with faith, like Bartimaeus means... "To live, grow and persevere in the faith until the end, we must nourish it with the word of God; we must beg the Lord to increase our faith; it must be "working through Charity", abounding in hope, and rooted in the faith of the Church" (Catechism of the Catholic Church #162). Jesus continues to speak to us in His Word, he teaches us as we pray and reflect and as we act on behalf of the poor, who open our eyes to His presence among us.

I recently met with a parishioner of St. Joseph parish who is interested in starting a **Book Club** which will read some of the great books that have continued to have an impact on many for centuries. These include St. Augustine, C.S. Lewis, among others. You're invited to gather at St. Joseph parish office (2565 3rd St, across from St. Joseph, Catholic Church in Trenton) today, **October 27 at 6:30 pm** to learn more and to share what you would like this book club to be like.

Why can't we just pray directly to God?

Why do we pray to saints? We pray differently to saints than we do to God. We recognize in the saints those who lived lives worth imitating. But at the same time, there's a famous quote that comes to mind: "Saints are sinners who kept trying." This sure gives me hope! We pray to saints for intercession for us. Have you ever asked someone to pray for you? I get asked that question a lot, and I ask that question as well. Praying to the saints is the same. Days like All Saints' Day is a great reminder to recommit, by being inspired by the lives of the saints. We also join in the communion of saints as we celebrate our shared salvation with the church in heaven.

There are certain moments where we acknowledge our union with the saints: during the Penitential Act, and for me, most profoundly when we pray the Sanctus, or Holy - the priest invokes "the angels and saints," as we proclaim, "Holy, Holy, Holy!" 12:00 noon Mass at Sacred Heart and St. Roch

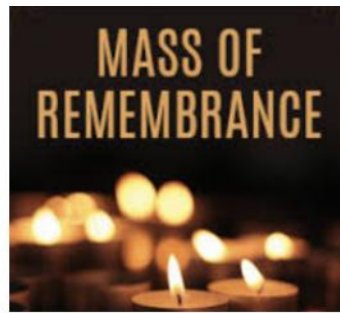

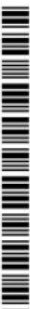
