
Why do we pray for the dead?

The month of November is a time when we pray for those who have gone before us. As almost 40 parishioners are going through Stephen Ministry training, we've been reflecting and preparing to minister to those who are grieving. One part of a recent session was to consider some things not to say. One that stood out that I hear often is, "he/she is in a better place." We don't know that! That's not our job to determine if someone is in heaven. That's God's job! In fact, we offer Mass intentions for people who have died. You hear during the Universal Prayer, a prayer for the intentions of the particular Mass - that is to assist that person with our prayers and the Church's prayer (the Mass) on their journey to heaven. "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (CCC, 1030). What the Catechism of the Catholic Church is saying here is that once in purgatory, there's only one direction we can go: heaven. So, what are some things we can do to pray for the dead?

- 1. Go to Mass! We pray for our loved ones and for all the dead at every Mass.
- 2. Light a candle in Church and pray for them.
- 3. Go to Masses for All Souls when they occur there is a Mass of Remembrance at St. Timothy on Mon., Nov. 4 at 7 pm.
- 4. Go to the 3rd Friday Mass at Our Lady of Hope Cemetery or simply visit the cemetery & pray for those laid to rest there.
- 5. Contact the parish office and have a Mass offered for your loved one who has died. Maybe this is on a particular birthday or anniversary, but it doesn't need to be.






