SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT DECEMBER 8, 2024

s is often the case in Advent, this Sunday's Gospel is concerned entirely with the figure of John the Baptist: the precursor of Jesus, whose birth we celebrate at Christmas.

Jesus referred to John the Baptist as "the greatest of the prophets" (cf. Luke 7:28). In the line of prophets that preceded him, and would follow him to this day, John the Baptist preached a word of justice and fairness.

To the tax collectors the says: "Do not mistreat anyone or commit extortion" (Luke 3:11-14). Today we could understand them thus: "Every unjust social difference between the very rich (the mountains) and the very poor (the valleys) must be eliminated or at least reduced; the crooked roads of corruption and deception must be made straight."

Up to this point we can easily recognize our contemporary understanding of a prophet: one who pushes for change; who denounces the injustices of the system, who points his finger against power in all its forms – religious, economic, military – and dares to cry out in the face of the tyrant: "It is not right!" (Matthew 14:4). But there is more to John the Baptist than even this very important message.

John the Baptist does not only announce a future salvation; he indicates in a most amazing way, a salvation that is now present. He points to Jesus (John 1:29). What a challenge it must have been for John to help people to see who he saw in Jesus the Christ!


John the Baptist, like all prophets does not predict the future like a soothsayer or a tarot card reader. He continues in the prophetic tradition of pointing the consequences of our contemporary decisions for our future. At times, our decisions reflect our faithfulness to God, and at other times not so much. Prophets have their finger on the pulse of his relationship between God and us. John the Baptist points us to Jesus, who came to heal that relationship once and for all and "to make ready for the Lord a people well prepared" (Luke 1:17).

Questions for Reflection:

- **1.** How is our world preparing for the return of the Savior? What do we do well? How can you and I do better?
- **2.** Sometimes being a messenger of hope can be a struggle. Are you struggling with hope? Is someone you know in need of encouragement?
- 3. Before we receive communion, the priest holds up the Body and Blood of Christ and says; "Behold the Lamb of God..."

 Who do you see when we gather around the table of the Lord? Do you see Jesus? Do you see anyone else along with him?

What happened to Immaculate Conception?

Today, December 8, is always the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, the Patroness of the United States. The Second Sunday of Advent supersedes this feast so because it is such a prominent feast in our country, it is moved to Monday, December 9. You'll see a good number of Mass times in our Family of Parishes. Usually, what are normally Holy Days of Obligation, if they fall on a Saturday or a Monday, they are not obligatory. This has recently changed. This year, Archbishop Vigneron has given a dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass for the Immaculate Conception; however, it is strongly recommended to attend Mass if you are able.

Have you noticed some "new" items around our parishes?

Whether it be vestments, an instrument, a Tabernacle, or other images from St. Timothy, the process after a parish closes is to disperse the sacred objects to neighboring parishes in our Family of Parishes. This is of course practical so the other parishes can benefit from the resources and stewardship of a parish that closes, but more than that - it allows the mission of St. Timothy to continue on in its members who will attend other parishes in our Family of Parishes. As we walk the path of discipleship with our brothers and sisters from St. Timothy, I am aware of the hurt and the need for accompaniment. Hopefully, seeing items from St. Timothy in the other parishes will give a small bit of comfort to them and all of us as we journey together.






