## Go Make of All Disciples

#### Can anything good come from Nazareth?

In John's Gospel, Nathaniel remarks, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" (John 1:46). Jesus' humble birth in a stable in Bethlehem and then the Holy Family's move back to Nazareth for the census, prompts the question from Nathaniel. Of course, as this story in Salvation History unfolds, we know the answer to this question. As Jesus responded to Nathaniel, he recognized who Jesus was and exclaimed, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." This king is who we have been waiting for in Advent - O Come, O Come, Emmanuel, recognizing that in the Emmanuel, God is truly with us.

Can anything good come from Riverview, Trenton, Flat Rock, Woodhaven, Grosse Ile, or Brownstown? As we celebrate Jesus' birth, Jesus' divinity joining our humanity, we recognize the good that can come from each of us as well. As followers of the Christ child, I encourage you to recognize God's gift to each of us at Christmas as well as the gift each of us are to one another. Another great way to open the gift Jesus wants to give us is to come to and/or invite someone to the Rescue Project. This is a 8-week journey of asking and answering basic questions of faith. This Christmas season, give someone the gift of faith - invite them to the Rescue Project. This program offered as a Family of Parishes, will be taking place at Our Lady of the Woods beginning on January 22. There will be a free meal, a talk, and an opportunity for small group discussion. 


## Music Ministry Epiphany Concert



items this coming week. We will be sending items to the Pope Francis Center, in Detroit, in January to help supply winter items to the needy.


A lot of what we get donated, supplies and finished items, come from people that don't leave their name. To all the anonymous donors THANK YOU SO MUCH.
