FEBRUARY 9, 2025

What do you think of when you think of tradition? Do you think of the crystal your family uses at Christmas? Perhaps the good food that you shared, or the way you sing Happy Birthday to a family member or a friend. In today's gospel Peter and the Apostles begin a journey that will insert them into the flow of the Church's tradition as they begin to follow Jesus and learn from his example.

Many times, when we think of tradition, we think of a stuffy or outmoded way of thinking that may no longer work in a rapidly changing world. Nothing can be further from the truth. Tradition evolves along the circumstances of the lives of those who cherish it. The truth about God does not change, but just as God sent Israel a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night to guide them through the desert, (Exodus 13) God guides us through this world in ways we can comprehend and follow. That way is Jesus. Christ's words and actions stand at the core of our Tradition and interpret our lives to this day. Tradition is formulated in doctrine and guarded by the magisterium (the teaching authority) of the Church. As Catholics, we swim in the flow of Scripture and tradition, two important currents which carry us forward as we seek to bear witness to Christ in the world.

The first reading today (Isaiah 6: 1-2a, 3-8) illustrates the way in which Scripture and tradition are integrated in the life of the church. We join the song of the angels in Isaiah's ecstatic vision: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts! All the earth is full of his glory!" Isaiah has a surprising reaction, as he cannot seem to join in this praise with the angels, because God's glory reminds him of his need to be humble in the face of such great beauty and glory. Do you see the glory of God in your own heart when you sing these words with us at mass?

Peter's successor Pope Benedict XVI knew something of tradition. He was one of the greatest theologians of the last century. He said; 'Apostolic Tradition is not a collection of things or words, like a box of dead things. Tradition is the river of new life that flows from the origins, from Christ down to us, and makes us participate in God's history with humanity.' Let's treasure and learn more about our tradition, as much as we treasure the food, the tastes, the songs, the smells the sights and voices of the traditions we have learned in our own homes, the Church's tradition is our home, and leads us back to the Father.

Who should receive the Anointing of the Sick?



A parish often receives calls when someone is dying for a priest to come and anoint their loved one. If this ever happens in your family, please call us! But other than the dying, who else can be anointed?

- Any member of the faithful can receive this sacrament as soon as he or she is considered to be in danger of death because of sickness.
- The elderly
- Those facing long illness or surgery

The anointing of the sick is administered to bring spiritual and even physical strength during an illness. The Letter of St. James (5:13-16). James instructs us on being anointed. The sick should turn to the priest, the priest is to pray over the person and anoint them with oil. In the anointing and in praying for one another, we pray for healing and strength. The actual prayer of anointing gives insight into its power and purpose:

Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit (while anointing the forehead). May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up (while anointing the hands). Amen.

Are there opportunities in our Family of Parishes?

First off, you can call any time you need this Sacrament. But there are designated times in a few of our parishes:

- First Thursday of the month at the 9 am Mass at St. Cyprian
- Second Friday of the month at the 9 am Mass at Our Lady of the Woods
- Third Thursday of the Month at the 9 am Mass at St. Roch

February 11 is designated as "World Day of the Sick." Pope Francis reminds us this year: Although true hope "does not disappoint," and in fact "strengthens us in times of trial," this confidence can often prove perplexing in real situations of suffering. "In these situations," the Pope says, we sense our need for a strength greater than our own. We realize that we need God's help, His grace, His Providence, and the strength that is the gift of His Spirit."

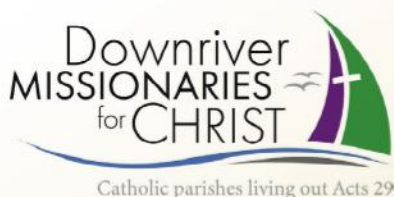
