Go Make of All Disciples

Do you find it easy to be a Catholic?

If the answer to this question is, “yes,” you’re doing it wrong! This may be harsh, but what Jesus calls us to is completely countercultural. Whether it be within our families, neighborhoods, friendships, or workplaces, Jesus calls us to love. As there are different kinds of love, particularly expressed in the Gospels, the word, “love,” here is more of an attitude and mode of action rather than emotion. We’ve all used the phrase, “we’ve let our emotions get the best of us.” Here, Jesus is inviting us to want good for another. Act well toward those who hate you. This is all very countercultural. It is a mark of a true disciple, to follow Jesus’ command. Jesus didn’t say, “If it is easy or not too painful for you, love your enemies.” He simply said, “Love your enemies.”

Jesus goes on to reveal other commands: stop judging, stop condemning, forgive, give, be merciful. As we hear and consider some of Jesus’ hardest teachings, these ideas go against our self-protective instincts. Jesus calls us not to self-preservation but to live

with radical love and generosity. Jesus is not going to judge us on someone else’s actions toward us. He is going to judge us in how we respond. As we approach Lent in just over a week, I encourage you to consider what you may do during Lent to grow as a follower of Jesus. Considering some of these very difficult commands of Jesus, maybe put aside giving up chocolate or pop. Maybe it is reconciling with an old friend, or forgiving a sibling you haven’t spoken to for a long time, or giving of your time and talent to serve those less fortunate.

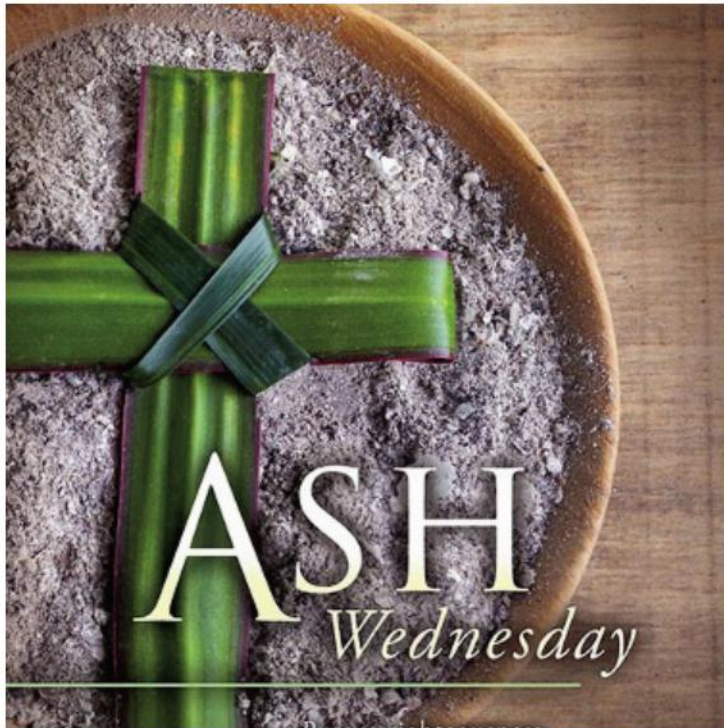
It is easy to do good to those who do good to you. Consider how you love those who do not do good to you. How do you love those who are difficult to love? Allow this time of preparation for Lent to be one of reflection on these commands of Jesus. When we receive Ashes on our foreheads in just over a week, let us “Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel.”
