Go Make of All Disciples

Where is God in all of this?

This is a question I hear often from people in their struggles. The Season of Lent provides us with some answers to this question. Scripture reminds us that Jesus faced all we had to face except sin. We now have an opportunity to embrace anew such struggles as Jesus faced. Like Jesus, the power of the Holy Spirit has been given to us, particularly in our baptism. This is why Lent is considered a baptismal season, recalling the presence of the Holy Spirit which gives us clarity. This clarity also invites us to deserted places where we can reflect more deeply on God's presence in our lives. When we fast, we sharpen our hunger for God.

As you enter the Church, go to the baptismal font, cross yourselves with Holy Water. This recalls your own baptism and recommits you as a disciple of Christ, recollecting that moment in your baptism where you first turned away from sin and committed yourself to the Gospel. We can connect our own temptations with the temptation of Jesus as reflected in today's Gospel (Luke 4:1-13). What's different for a Christian in temptation, is that we have God on our side. So, where is God in all of this? God is in the joys, challenges, temptations, struggles, and moments of overcoming sin in our lives.


