What is a Small Group?

It is a gathering of 6-10 people who meet regularly to connect with others and grow in faith together. Often, a small group is composed of particular demographics (below are examples but not limited to this list):

- Men or women
- Widows
- Young adults
- Single parents
- Young couples (engaged or married)
- Grief support
- Young parents

How often do they meet?

Some groups meet weekly, bi-weekly or monthly. This could be done in blocks. Maybe there's a book study for a couple of months, then a break before meeting again. Other groups may want to read and pray with the upcoming Sunday readings during the school year. The group will decide the content and the pace of meeting.

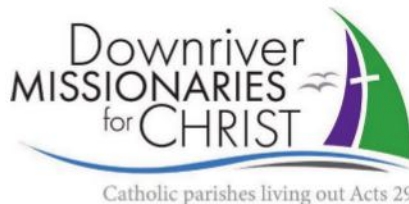

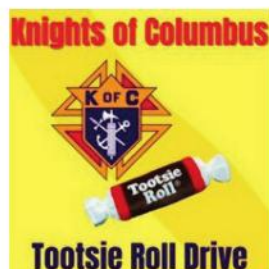
