Go Make of All Disciples

Are You Sleeping?

This question of Jesus to his disciples occurs in Luke's Passion account that we heard today right before Jesus' betrayal and arrest. He pleaded with his disciples who were sleeping to rise and pray that they may not enter into temptation. The temptation is of turning away from Jesus and not acknowledging Him as Lord. How many times have we turned our back on Jesus and not acknowledged Him as the Lord of our lives? I certainly have! As we walk these days of Holy Week, take time reflecting on this question? What areas of our lives need reawakening? Would Jesus find us sleeping? Where would you be during this Passion narrative?

A way to respond to these questions is to participate in the events of Holy Week. There are daily Masses Monday through Wednesday in our Family of Parishes, and each of our parishes celebrates the Paschal Triduum, which is the 3 days: Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. I encourage you to look at the schedule for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter. If you have never been to an Easter Vigil before, consider it! I promise you won't be disappointed! Through the darkness of death, the light of Christ's Resurrection will shine anew on us this night.

Are you sleeping? Do you need to awaken your faith? Do you have questions? Join us. We're here with open arms and open doors. Allow for the door of faith in your heart to be opened to experience the love and mercy of Jesus who put each of our sins on the Cross with Him.

Pray for those entering the Church at Easter!

We have a number of children and adults being received into the Church this Easter and throughout the Easter Season. Please keep them in prayer particularly this week but through the Easter Season, that this encounter with the Risen Christ will inspire them as well as each of us to keep the flame of faith that we all receive in baptism alive and well!

The Resurrection of the Lord

Jesus is alive! Jesus is Risen! Alleluia!

The Resurrection is not a theory, but an historical fact. It is not a myth, or vision, or a fairy tale but a singular, unrepeatable event. Jesus died on a Friday afternoon, was taken down from the cross and left in the tomb. He was seen and recognized as risen. What should we believe about Jesus' resurrection?

We invite you to deepen your understanding about the Paschal Mystery: The Mystery of Jesus' Death, Resurrection, and Ascension. Easter calls for a radical conversion which results in our becoming "new," a newness that changes us and the lives of all who accept it. The risen Jesus went to real lengths to show that he was alive and tried to convince believers that what happened is a part of a divine plan. He continues to give us the same commissioning that he gave to the disciples:

"Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19)


