# Go Make of All Disciples

## Why do you doubt?

Thomas said, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into his side, I will not believe" (John 20:19-31). Wow! Can you believe that one of Jesus' closest followers, after all that had happened, and after all that Jesus said would happen, just went with the crowd of disbelief? And shortly before, Peter denied Jesus not one, but three times! I would say we are in pretty good company. This is now 2025 years later and we haven't seen Jesus physically walking with us in person as people like Peter and Thomas did.

I have the pleasure of talking with many people while serving our communities. Those who are struggling in faith will often say they have questions and have doubts. Sometimes that may be code for, "I am not into this." But, for those who do have doubts or questions about faith, the only way to wrestle with those questions or doubts is to pray, participate, and receive the Sacraments. Maybe some of those questions are due to the fact we have sinned and have pulled ourselves away from the love and mercy of God. Going to Confession and receiving the Eucharist are great remedies to the doubt in our hearts.

Jesus goes on to say, "Blessed are those who have not seen and believed." We have not seen Jesus in the way His disciples did. We as disciples of Jesus here and now have to walk by faith, not by sight. Allow Jesus to open the door of your heart so His peace can permeate every aspect of your life. Jesus continues to walk with each of us, in our struggles, joys, doubts, grief, and hope. Are you going to be like Thomas or are you going to be like the one who has not seen and still believed?

## Divine Mercy Sunday

A Universal Church Feast  
observed on the  
First Sunday after Easter  
**Sunday, April 27, 2025**

In her *Diary*, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska recorded 14 revelations from our Lord requesting this feast. The most complete, concise description is found in entry 699:

**I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. ... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.**

To receive the extraordinary graces of this feast, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the vigil celebration) by making a good Confession beforehand and staying in the state of grace, and receive with great trust in Divine Mercy.



On Sunday, April 27, The Feast of Divine Mercy, right after the 11:00 Liturgy, in Room B in the Parish Office, we will view a DVD called "St. Faustina." The film will summarize this unique vision and promise given by Jesus to this holy Polish sister, and will be followed by a discussion about the unusual plenary indulgence.

Many of our neighbors in the southwest Detroit area live with "more month than money"—where a paycheck runs out before the bills do. Elian—a local resident on disability—visits the Perry Outreach Center monthly for a box of groceries and a warm hello. When he leaves, it's not just with food, but with dignity—he knows he's not alone.

The Perry Center is more than a pantry. Once a ministry of Ss. Andrew and Benedict parish, we are now a community-led nonprofit serving over 100 families a month with food, health screenings, job assistance, and music and computer classes. We reopened in 2024 with zero dollars, but not zero hope.

## The Resurrection of the Lord

**Jesus is alive! Jesus is Risen! Alleluia!**

The Resurrection is not a theory, but an historical fact. It is not a myth, or vision, or a fairy tale but a singular, unrepeatable event. Jesus died on a Friday afternoon, was taken down from the cross and left in the tomb. He was seen and recognized as risen. What should we believe about Jesus' resurrection?

We invite you to deepen your understanding about the Paschal Mystery: The Mystery of Jesus' Death, Resurrection, and Ascension. Easter calls for a radical conversion which results in our becoming "new," a newness that changes us and the lives of all who accept it.

The risen Jesus went to real lengths to show that he was alive and tried to convince believers that what happened is a part of a divine plan. He continues to give us the same commissioning that he gave to the disciples:

*"Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19)*

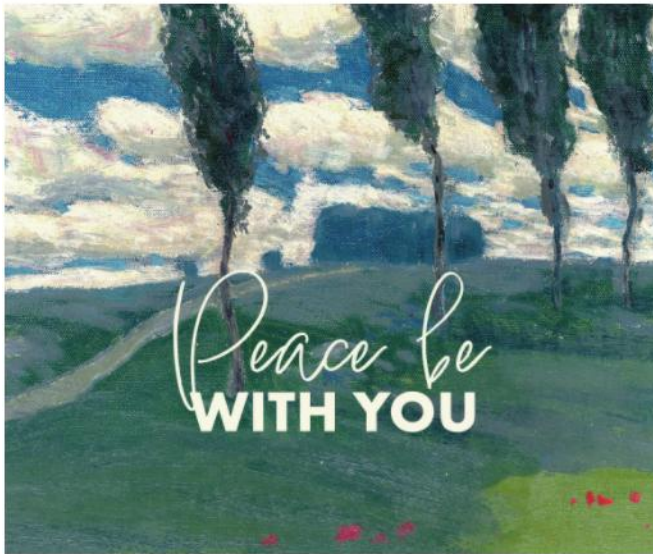
