Go Make of All Disciples

Why do you doubt?

Thomas said, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into his side, I will not believe" (John 20:19-31). Wow! Can you believe that one of Jesus' closest followers, after all that had happened, and after all that Jesus said would happen, just went with the crowd of disbelief? And shortly before, Peter denied Jesus not one, but three times! I would say we are in pretty good company. This is now 2025 years later and we haven't seen Jesus physically walking with us in person as people like Peter and Thomas did.

I have the pleasure of talking with many people while serving our communities. Those who are struggling in faith will often say they have questions and have doubts. Sometimes that may be code for, "I am not into this." But, for those who do have doubts or questions about faith, the only way to wrestle with those questions or doubts is to pray, participate, and receive the Sacraments. Maybe some of those questions are due to the fact we have sinned and have pulled ourselves away from the love and mercy of God. Going to Confession and receiving the Eucharist are great remedies to the doubt in our hearts.

Jesus goes on to say, "Blessed are those who have not seen and believed." We have not seen Jesus in the way His disciples did. We as disciples of Jesus here and now have to walk by faith, not by sight. Allow Jesus to open the door of your heart so His peace can permeate every aspect of your life. Jesus continues to walk with each of us, in our struggles, joys, doubts, grief, and hope. Are you going to be like Thomas or are you going to be like the one who has not seen and still believed?

The Resurrection of the Lord

Jesus is alive! Jesus is Risen! Alleluia!

The Resurrection is not a theory, but an historical fact. It is not a myth, or vision, or a fairy tale but a singular, unrepeatable event. Jesus died on a Friday afternoon, was taken down from the cross and left in the tomb. He was seen and recognized as risen. What should we believe about Jesus' resurrection?

We invite you to deepen your understanding about the Paschal Mystery: The Mystery of Jesus' Death, Resurrection, and Ascension. Easter calls for a radical conversion which results in our becoming "new," a newness that changes us and the lives of all who accept it.

The risen Jesus went to real lengths to show that he was alive and tried to convince believers that what happened is a part of a divine plan. He continues to give us the same commissioning that he gave to the disciples:

"Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holv Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19)




