Peace I leave with you

These words of Jesus in today's gospel are also words our new Pope Leo XIV has echoed enough to be called the "pope of peace." But it isn't just up to Jesus or the pope to bring peace. It is up to each of us. And not just peace but the peace of Christ. When we offer a sign of peace at Mass, it's not just a moment to say hello to the people around us or to catch up with those we haven't seen in a while. That can happen after Mass. In that particular moment, right before we receive the Eucharist, we offer Christ's peace. It's also a recognition that we should not receive the Eucharist before making peace with our brother or sister in Christ.

When we prepare ourselves to receive the Eucharist, our hearts should not be troubled. Jesus proclaims this today as well. Not only should we approach the table of the Lord with clean hands and pure hearts, we should do so untroubled, and at peace with our brothers and sisters in Christ. As Jesus reminds us today, the Holy Spirit will remain with each of us. That presence prompts us and reminds us all of what Jesus taught us. All of this is what Jesus instructed us: because Jesus gave us His peace, we must extend that peace to others. To do so untroubled and unafraid, recalling all that Jesus taught us is a gift from God that we must share with others. As Jesus prepares his disciples for his Ascension into heaven (as we will celebrate next Sunday), the Lord's presence will always be within us, reminding us of all that the Lord has told us.

As a follower of Jesus, as a disciple, we are reminded today to love the Lord, keep His words, bring peace, recognize the presence of the Holy Spirit in each of our lives - prompting and guiding us toward life in Christ. Allow the Lord to make His dwelling within you, so you can truly be the peace of Christ in the world.


