Go Make of All Disciples

What does it mean to witness?

As we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord into heaven, the Gospel (Luke 24:46-53) as well as the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, which is a continuation of the Gospel of Luke (Acts 1:1-11), we are told we are to be witnesses. We are often encouraged to witness to the faith. But what does that mean? If we are witnesses to a crime, we may have to sit on the witness stand and tell the account of what we saw. But what are we witnessing to in relation to our faith? Psalm 126 tells us that "The Lord has done great things for us." If God has done something great for us, of course we want to tell others. Today's responsorial Psalm (47) exclaims, "Shout to God with cries of gladness," and "Sing praise to God."

What are we praising? We are praising the Lord who has fulfilled all that He has promised. Everything from the Old Testament that was prophesied, as well as all that Jesus said would happen, really happened! Unfortunately, many do not feel the Lord's presence in their lives. That does not mean the Lord is truly making Himself present to us (particularly in the Word and the Eucharist), but the witnesses of these things need to be louder! Our second reading (Ephesians 1:17-23) tells us, "May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know what is the hope that belongs to his call."

This draws me to one word: hope. In this Jubilee Year of Hope, we are invited to pause, pray, seek the Lord's pardon, and praise him for his merciful grace. I encourage you to participate in this Jubilee Year by going to https://www.aod.org/jubilee. Allow this to be a moment of renewed faith in your life, so you can be witnesses to God's love and mercy in your life. St. Paul begins this weekend's second reading: "May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him." I hope in this Jubilee Year we will all take time for prayer and reflection on all that God has done for us, that we be His witnesses.
