Go Make of All Disciples

Are you in a relationship?

Maybe you're married, dating, or have close friendships? These relationships have to be fostered. What does that mean? Time and effort is needed to build that relationship. We cannot just assume closeness without some sort of effort on our part. On the Lord's part, that closeness and communion is an absolute. This means that regardless of our desire to be in relationship with God, God continues to dwell with each of us. The first reading from Proverbs (8:22-31) says of the wisdom of God: "The Lord possessed me..." God takes possession of us in our baptism, when we become God's adopted son or daughter. That relationship, however, begins as God creates us in our mother's womb. How wonderful is the name of God in all the earth (Psalm 8).

The Most Holy Trinity gives us an example of relationship. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit - three divine persons in one God. Each has its own purpose but are in a divine communion with one another. Each of us has our own purpose. The gifts and the breath of the Holy Spirit lives within each of us. Our second reading last weekend on the Solemnity of Pentecost speaks to some of this reality: "No one can say Jesus is Lord, except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13). Without a healthy relationship of life and love in the context of the Church, part of the body of Christ is missing. I invite you to reflect on the gifts God has given you and how the Spirit is manifested in you for the benefit of others.

If you're not planning to attend the 10:30 Mass, please gather right outside the main doors of the Church.


