Go Make of All Disciples

Are we in Ordinary Time yet?

Yes! In fact, Ordinary Time began the day after Pentecost Sunday. Every year the two Sundays after Pentecost are the Solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity and the Body and Blood of Christ. But, the weekdays are from Ordinary Time, which will go until Advent. Why is next Sunday different? There are some Solemnities that are basically high enough in "rank" to take the place of a Sunday during Ordinary Time. The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul is one of those days. This particular solemnity has a unique place in the history of the Church: it is one of the oldest observances in the Church's liturgical calendar. Legend has it that on June 29 in the year 64, these two great apostles met for a final embrace in Rome before departing for their martyrdom. These days of remembering martyrs and other saints really began the way we celebrate various saints and moments in the Church's history.

So, in two weeks we will begin the normal cycle of Sundays of Ordinary Time. We celebrate Sunday after Sunday, of course first and foremost a "little Easter" as St. John Paul II describes in his encyclical on the Day of the Lord. But we also celebrate the mystery of Christ. This includes all that takes place in Jesus' public ministry: parables, healing, teaching, all leading to prepare his disciples to lead the Church after Jesus' passion, death, resurrection and ascension into heaven. This is exactly what Peter, the first pope, and Paul, the one who wrote much of the New Testament, prepared for. This is what they died for. As we hear the Gospel proclaimed next Sunday, we will hear Jesus asking the questions of his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" Peter exclaimed, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13-19). Let us, as Peter and Paul affirmed with their life and their death, acclaim Christ as the Lord of our lives. There's nothing ordinary about life in Christ.






