Go Make of All Disciples

Do you turn to the Lord in your need?

It's easy to be a follower of Jesus when things are going well. But what about in moments of loss, struggle, illness, or difficult transition or circumstance in life? Psalm 69 (one of the options for the Liturgy of the Word today), instructs us to turn to the Lord in our need. Our response will be this: that you may live. When things don't make sense, turn to the Lord. When things are great, turn to the Lord. In your deepest struggles and temptations in life, turn to the Lord. The psalmist reminds us that the Lord hears our prayers and encourages us that our hearts will revive. I encourage you to lean into the Psalms in your prayer. It is an ancient practice to pray the Psalms as part of morning and evening prayer, or the "Liturgy of the Hours." If you are interested, you could always search it on the internet, but at the least, just open your Bible and explore the Psalms. They really cover a full range of emotions - fear, loss, praise, supplication, and more!

Theology on Tap - Young Adult Ministry

This Thursday, July 17 from 7-9, young adults (18-35) are invited to Mr. Nick's on West Rd. for what's called, "Theology on Tap." It's simply an opportunity to come together in a more comfortable environment and talk faith. Fr. Marc will give a simple talk, but it is also an opportunity to gather socially, ask questions, and just be with other believers. If you are a young adult, please come! If you know young adults, particularly ones that may be less engaged in their faith, this kind of a gathering is a perfect shallow entry point to engage them in their faith.

Faith Formation Registration

Children's faith formation registration is open and we are having many families already registering for various offerings in our parishes. One thing I have noticed in the last couple of years is that families are coming forth to baptize their older children, or bring their children for the sacraments in a much later age. So often, the first thing a parent does is apologize. There's absolutely nothing to apologize for! God calls and we respond. Yes, there is a normative time for things (baptism

as an infant, for example). But praise God that parents recognize the importance of a life in Christ. So, with that said, there is no wrong time. We have received many children into the Church these last couple of years and continue to welcome new families. If you are in that circumstance or you know someone, please have them reach out to me!



Virtues, Gifts, and the Fruits of the Holy Spirit

The descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-11) was the moment that the Church was specifically endowed with power with the manifestation of the Holy Spirit's gifts. Christians receive these gifts at Baptism and they are renewed at Confirmation. We will reflect on the many gifts and virtues that are within each person who has received these sacraments, that they will be stirred into flame and become manifest in our personal lives and in our life in the Church.

A spiritual gift is a supernatural ability or capacity given by God to enable the Christian to minister and serve. God wills that every Christian exercise spiritual gifts. Every baptized Christian has been given a "charism" or special gift or special grace from the Holy Spirit to empower them to perform a particular kind of service to build up the life of the Church (CCC #2003).

St. Paul said, "To each is given a manifestation of the Spirit for the common good" (1 Cor 12:7) and "...each has his own special gift from God, one of one kind, and one of another" (Cor 7:7)

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit are the natural outgrowth or evidence of the Holy Spirit's presence and work in the believer's character. Virtues, both human and theological, are habitual dispositions to do good. They are perfected and enabled by the gifts and demonstrated through the fruits of the Holy Spirit.

These presentations provide an introduction to anyone seeking to know more about Spiritual Gifts, the Fruits of the Holy Spirit, and Virtues.


