Do you call on the Lord for help?

I think the most common forms of prayer for people is a prayer of petition: "Lord, help me with this problem," or, "Lord, I need something." This prayer of petition is one of five typical ideas of prayer:

I encourage you to consider these different forms of prayer and maybe focus on one you aren't as used to deploying. For example, maybe you are good at praying for others, but you don't take time often enough to give thanks to God for all God does for us. Allow this time of self



reflection to draw closer to the Lord. Right in the Responsorial Psalm today from Psalm 138, the psalmist exclaims, "I will give thanks to you, O Lord, with all my heart, for you have heard the words of my mouth...! will worship at your holy temple." It's not enough to say a quick prayer for someone or something, but God calls us into worship and adoration. We do that in community week after week on the Lord's day.

Use the prayer of our Psalm today as the beginning of your prayer: "Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me." Maybe God answers just like we hope, or maybe God answers in the way God knows and in knowing what we really need. And God's time is different than our time. Patience in prayer is real necessity. Often, people get frustrated in prayer because they don't get answered quickly or in a way we want. Let God be in control of it! May we always be persistent in prayer.



Virtues, Gifts, and the Fruits of the Holy Spirit

The descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-11) was the moment that the Church was specifically endowed with power with the manifestation of the Holy Spirit's gifts. Christians receive these gifts at Baptism and they are renewed at Confirmation. We will reflect on the many gifts and virtues that are within each person who has received these sacraments, that they will be stirred into flame and become manifest in our personal lives and in our life in the Church.

A spiritual gift is a supernatural ability or capacity glven by God to enable the Christian to minister and serve. God wills that every Christian exercise spiritual gifts. Every baptized Christian has been given a "charism" or special gift or special grace from the Holy Spirit to empower them to perform a particular kind of service to build up the life of the Church (CCC #2003).

St. Paul said, "To each is given a manifestation of the Spirit for the common good" (1 Cor 12:7) and "...each has his own special gift from God, one of one kind, and one of another" (Cor 7:7)

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit are the natural outgrowth or evidence of the Holy Spirit's presence and work in the believer's character. Virtues, both human and theological, are habitual dispositions to do good. They are perfected and enabled by the gifts and demonstrated through the fruits of the Holy Spirit.




