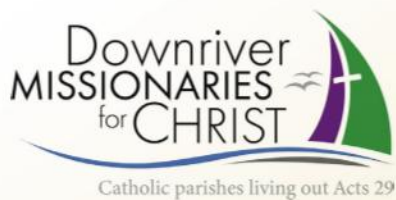

Sacred Heart High School Life Teen went to Gleaners on July 28th. We assembled food boxes for children and families who are no longer getting food at schools for the summer.

We assisted with collectively feeding families 11,475 lbs., of food which breaks down to a total of 9,180 meals for families.

Studying the Sunday Readings

Besides prayerful meditation on Sacred Scripture and attentive listening when it is read at Mass, one of the most effective ways to grow in understanding and love for the Bible is to join a group that meets to discuss the Sunday Readings which will be proclaimed at the next Eucharistic liturgy.

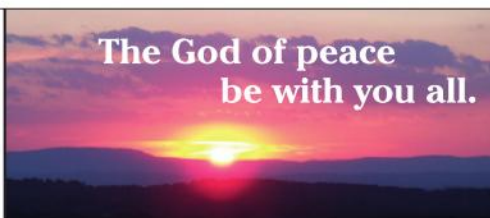

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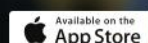
