Did you know we have a ministry to those who are grieving?

Our one-on-one Stephen Ministry is available for anyone experiencing any grief or loss in their lives. We have over 30 trained Stephen Ministers, who are parishioners of the parishes in our Family of Parishes. We have 13 people currently in the care of a Stephen Minister. I know it can be a humbling experience, acknowledging the fact that you may need some spiritual support with your grief. The only way people know of this opportunity of healing is for you to tell them about it. If you know someone in your life who is hurting in some way, we can help. Direct them to our Stephen Ministry. If nothing else, they can call the parish office, but also email fopstephenministry@gmail.com.

So what do we do when we meet in Stephen Ministry? It's simply a safe and confidential place to share whatever is on your heart and mind. We would meet individually, typically once a week, for as long as you need. Some begin to taper off after a while of working through some healing. So, you may go to bi-weekly, then monthly. The goal is to get you in a place of healing where you can work through a new normal in your life. Our Stephen Ministers are trained in spiritual care and support of people in moments of grief and loss. Pray for our Stephen Ministers, but also pray that those whose hearts are stuck in a place in their lives that healing is needed.

This is also for people who aren't necessarily stuck but who need some spiritual care and guidance after a loss. The worst thing that happens is that you meet with a Stephen Minister a few times and find in that encounter the healing and peace that you have sought out. Know that our Stephen Ministry is here for anyone who seeks, anyone who comes searching for healing and peace in their lives.

From Archbishop Weisenburger: Special Collection for Gaza

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops asks all dioceses across the U.S. are asked to take up an emergency collection for the suffering of Gaza. The issue is catastrophic and I'm humbly asking you to take up a second collection as requested at your earliest convenience.

Joining bishops across the United States, Archbishop Edward J. Weisenburger is urging Detroit-area Catholics "to be most generous" this week and next in supporting a "critical collection" to provide emergency humanitarian aid for the starving people of Gaza, a crisis that has reached "catastrophic" levels, he said. The collection, sponsored by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, will be taken up the weekends of August 16-17 and August 23-24 in Detroit-area parishes.






