As I wrote about last weekend, September 14 is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. Here, we recognize and celebrate the victory that Christ's suffering and death brings about for each of us. Wow, what a gift, to be redeemed, forgiven of sins, and offered eternal life! Of course, we give thanks and praise that by Jesus' holy cross, He has redeemed the world. The very next day, September 15, the Church celebrates the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows. This day's feast celebrates a particular aspect of Mary's discipleship: her unwavering faithfulness to Christ, which led her to follow him all the way to the cross. While other disciples fled after Jesus' arrest, and despite her own imaginable grief, she remained with her suffering Son. Mary has taught us how to grieve. Standing at the foot of the cross, Mary is an icon for the Church, who has called to be faithful to Christ no matter the cost. Mary remains with the suffering members of the Body of Christ wherever they are.

Mary has certainly inspired people to accompany those who are grieving. Our Stephen Ministry does just that: if you are grieving any sort of loss, you are not alone.
