Go Make of All Disciples

Have you ever asked someone to pray for you?

I sure have! There's real power in prayer. Prayer for someone or something doesn't change God: it changes us! Catholics sometimes get questions around why we have saints. Not only are saints wonderful examples of living the Catholic faith, they are interceding for us. To pray to the saints for intercession is absolutely different than praying to God. Saint Brigid, for example, will not answer prayers. God answers prayers, in God's own time. It would be appropriate to pray to Saint Bridgid to intercede on your behalf. I raise this as the Church has two new saints: St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Carlo Acutis. It has surely drawn a lot of media attention as these are the first saints Pope Leo XIV has canonized, but also because St. Carlo particularly, was the first millennial to be canonized.

Canonization is a declaration by the Pope that a deceased person is raised to full honors of the altar. Two miracles must be credited to the person, meaning someone prayed to that person for their intercession and were healed of some ailment. For example, the healing of Domenico Sellan through the intercession of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati, who was dying of tuberculosis in 1933. As the fall unfolds toward the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1, I encourage you to pray about a patron saint for your life. Maybe it is connected to your profession (St. Florian for firefighters for example), or maybe revisiting your Confirmation name (mine is St. Joseph!).

Our Faith Formation Year opens on Monday, September 29!

Our children's faith formation programs in our family of parishes begins with a Mass at 6 pm at St. Cyprian for all of our faith formation programs. Everyone is welcome to attend and pray for our young people exploring the faith. The Mass is for the Feast of Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, Archangels. This is another way to pray to the saints for intercession. I pray for our young people, entrusting them to the Archangels and to their Guardian

Angels as they embark on a new catechetical year. I invite you into that prayer as well.




