Go Make of All Disciples

Are you weary?

Jesus in today's Gospel (Luke 18:1-8), tells his disciples to pray without becoming weary. Speaking as someone in a regular habit of prayer, it is easy at times to become weary. What keeps me grounded, however, is the consistency in prayer anyway. The tasks of daily life, the business of this time of year can certainly make me weary! The readings this weekend give us some hope but also equip us in moments of weariness.

1. The support of Aaron for Moses in the first reading (Exodus 17:8-13). When we are tired and weary, others can support us.
2. The responsorial Psalm (121) reminds us that our help comes from the Lord and it is the Lord who will guide us.
3. The second reading (2 Timothy 3:14 - 4:2) instructs us to be rooted and grounded in Scripture. St. Paul tells us to be persistent in proclaiming the word, whether it is convenient or inconvenient. The same goes for prayer. Whether it is convenient or inconvenient, persist in your life of prayer.

Do you know we have adults seeking faith in the Catholic Church?

I am always inspired by the many adults from various stages in their lives and in their spiritual journeys, who seek the Lord in the Church. We have some in our parishes processes right now for Christian Initiation who have not been baptized (a couple who were part of the Rescue Project last year). We have people who were baptized Catholic but never went on in their faith journey until now. Others were baptized into other faith traditions and are now seeking the Lord's presence in the Catholic Church. From whatever pathways, they have come because of your witness to the faith. The first time someone walked into Sacred Heart or Our Lady of the Woods, or one of our other parishes, they felt the presence of the Lord and wanted to be a part of it.

This is why your persistence in prayer, proclamation of the Word, and your witness to the faith is so crucial not only to newcomers, but also for us as we continue to build up the Body of Christ. Pray for these people as they continue their journey toward encountering Christ in the Sacraments of Initiation. Let it also renew us in our desire to encounter the Lord through the Sacraments, particularly in moments of weariness.

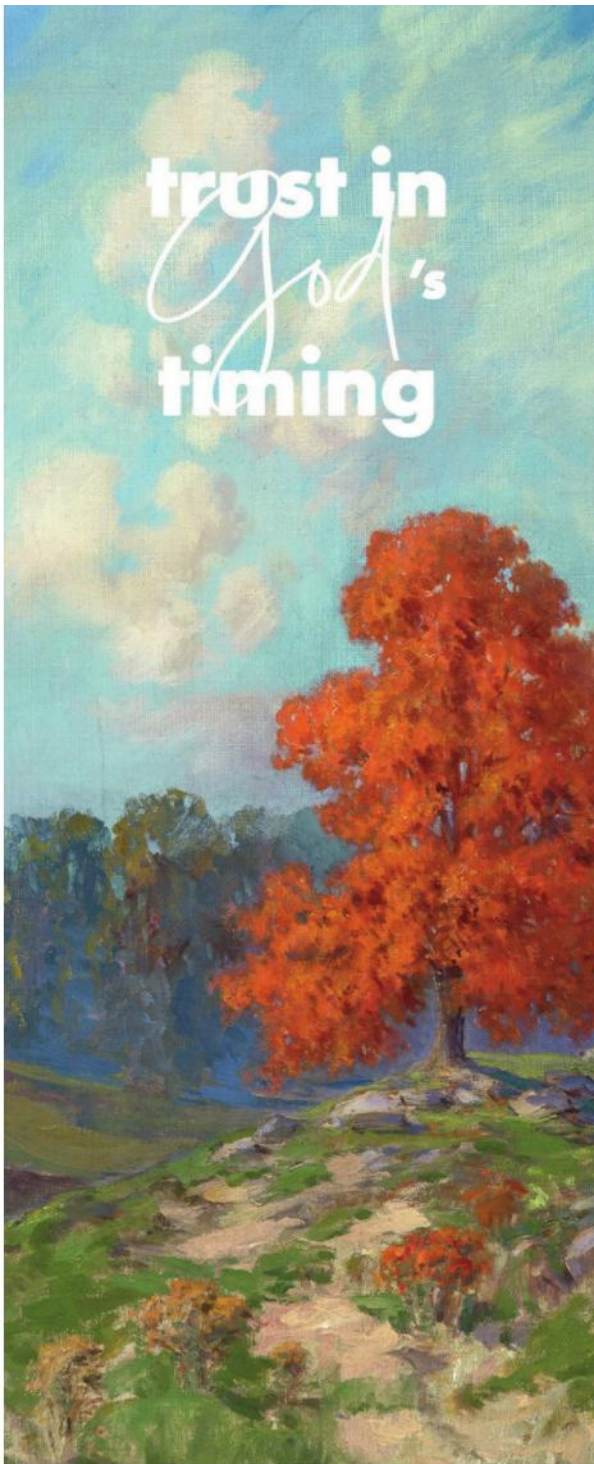

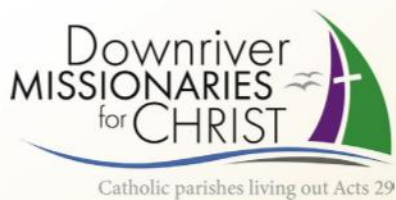

Eschatology: The Last Things

What Happens After We Die?

This is the question that is deep in the human heart and we have been asking that question since the dawn of time. We have archaeological evidence that the earliest humans buried their dead with items indicating a hope for an afterlife. In modern times, a Google research for "life after death" comes up with two BILLION results. With a mixture of curiosity, fear, and hope, all of us long to know what happens after death.

The Church has long taught that prayerful consideration of that area of theology called Eschatology, which is the "study of last things" which are various final moments or stages: death, particular judgment, purgatory, heaven, hell, Second Coming of Christ, general judgment, consummation of all things in the perfection of the Kingdom of God. This study is an essential part of our growth and maturation as Christians. Unless we take these things seriously, our life here on earth will lack meaning and focus. It is only when we consider the decisions we make in the light of eternity that our entire lives begin to make sense and our relationship with God can come to full maturity.

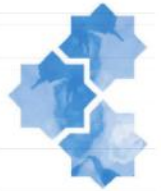


