# Go Make of All Disciples

## Who do you imitate?

St. Paul in our second reading today (2 Thessalonians 3:7-12), talks of imitation of people. St. Paul states that, "You know how one must imitate us." If we truly live as a Christian, people should notice something different about us: how we work, how we treat people, how we spend our time. Living and acting as a disciple of Jesus is difficult. It is countercultural and this reading gives some marching orders. Work so as to not burden others, be a model for others, and only eat if you are willing to work. But what about the people who are hungry and in need of food? Of course it is our mission to feed the hungry. Fr. Rooney once said in a homily that we won't be judged at what people do with the outreach and ministry we provide, but rather we will be judged if we help those in need.

So, we should be a good model of living as a disciple of Jesus. As we approach a season where many Christian service activities provide for the poor, let us model the faith to those who are less fortunate and provide for their needs.

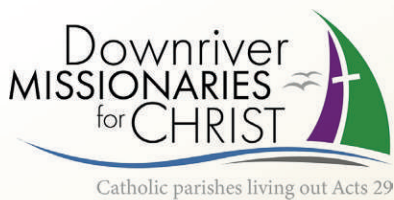

## A Journey from Grief to Hope:

**A four-week seminar dealing with the loss of a loved one.** The goal of this seminar is to reach out to others who have lost a loved one, to comfort them, to console, and to cultivate spiritual and emotional healing from your loss. We will do this by covering the Ten Stages of Grief. Studies have been done to try to learn how loss affects us and how we react to grief through various stages. We do not go through them in the same order and we don't stay in them the same amount of time. Many come through these stages with a deeper understanding of oneself at a new stage of life as a part of the growth that can occur having gone through the grief process. Reasons to attend:

1. You should know that there are many who have experienced a loss and you are not alone.
2. You could use a few new friends.
3. You need a kind word and listening ear.
4. Your prayer is "Lord, I have no idea where I am going."
5. God wants you to take a chance on HIM...He is waiting for you.
6. Most importantly... Jesus wants you to continue your journey from grief to hope!
