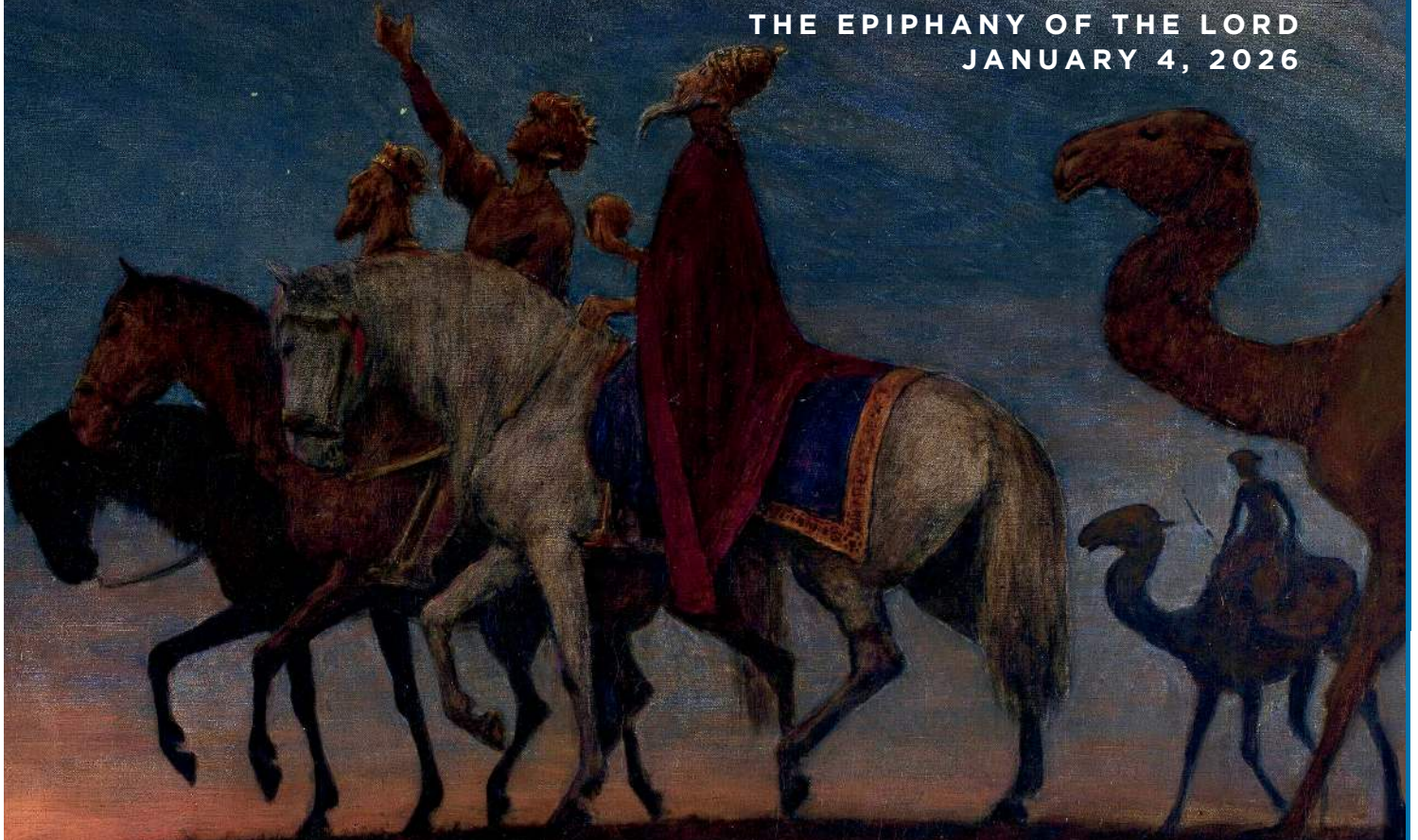

Join Us for The Ultreya

Please join us once a month for a faith sharing experience – Ultreya. Ultreya; is a Spanish word, derived from the original Latin, meaning “Onward!” It was in common use by pilgrims to greet and to encourage one another while walking along the Camino de Compostela in Spain in medieval times. This word is now used by the Cursillo community to signify the meeting which is held after a Cursillo experience. This meeting may be between Cursillistas from one or several communities as well as those who want to meet with like-minded individuals looking to deepen their relationship with God.

We are all pilgrims on a journey and, we too, need people to encourage and cheer us on our way. The Ultreya meeting is a means of encouraging each other in faith, sharing our lives in friendship, living out Christianity within a community, and supporting each other as we follow the path of our everyday life. The goal of each Ultreya is to help us transform our world for Christ. You will also have an opportunity to hear a lay member of the community share with us how they are living their life for Jesus.

The Ultreya is led by lay leaders who have attended a Cursillo weekend and is supported by a spiritual advisor at the meetings. The Ultreya for the Downriver area will be held at St. Joseph's in Trenton on the second Monday of the month from 6:30-8:30 pm in the parish office building.

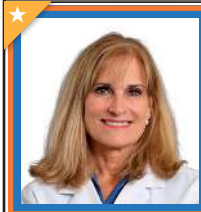


