## Merry Christmas!

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the conclusion of the Christmas season. I love how we celebrate! Christmas particularly celebrates an Octave, which means we celebrate Christmas day for 8 days! Then, recalling the song, "The Twelve Days of Christmas," we extend a bit to the Epiphany. This is traditionally 12 days after Christmas; however, the Church transfers it to Sunday now to allow for more people to come and celebrate that particular Solemnity. Today, however, is the culmination of manifestations of Christ that we celebrate during the Christmas season. It is an opportunity for us to reflect about the many ways Christ is manifested in our own lives.

Jesus was baptized to make holy the water for our baptism. This was Jesus' inauguration to his public ministry. Our baptism is the same. Yes, we are all called to ministry. That can take various forms. Some are ordained, some are paid "professionals." Many thankfully offer themselves in various ways to serve the Church: cleaning linens for use at Mass, decorating, preparing the Altar, serving as a catechist, volunteering around the parish office, counting money, greeting people as they arrive at Mass, offering their talents in music ministry, and so many other ways. Many of these ministries are out of the public eye and unseen. There is a gentleman at one of our parishes that opens the Church every day, cleans up, replaces votive candles and spends time in prayer. Nobody sees many of the great ways people wish to spend their time.

I invite you to consider your own gifts and talents. Through your baptism, God has gifted you with charisms. How can you use them in the service of others? When God gives these gifts/charisms, we must use them for others. Our nourishment for whatever ministry God calls us to is the Word and the Eucharist. In this new year, take some time to renew yourself in the Word of God and in the Eucharist.

# Join Us for The Ultreya

Please join us once a month for a faith sharing experience - Ultreya. Ultreya; is a Spanish word, derived from the original Latin, meaning "**Onward!**" It was in common use by pilgrims to greet and to encourage one another while walking along the Camino de Compostela in Spain in medieval times. This word is now used by the Cursillo community to signify the meeting which is held after a Cursillo experience. This meeting may be between Cursillistas from one or several communities as well as those who want to meet with like-minded individuals looking to deepen their relationship with God.

We are all pilgrims on a journey and, we too, need people to encourage and cheer us on our way. The Ultreya meeting is a means of encouraging each other in faith, sharing our lives in friendship, living out Christianity within a community, and supporting each other as we follow the path of our everyday life. The goal of each Ultreya is to help us transform our world for Christ. You will also have an opportunity to hear a lay member of the community share with us how they are living their life for Jesus.

The Ultreya is led by lay leaders who have attended a Cursillo weekend and is supported by a spiritual advisor at the meetings. The Ultreya for the Downriver area will be held at St. Joseph's in Trenton on the second Monday of the month from 6:30-8:30 pm in the parish office building.


