

## Why do we do that? Catholic Life Explained

## Question: What does the Church say about suicide?

**Answer:** Unfortunately, despite the Church's clear teachings in resources like the Catechism of the Catholic Church, there are still many people who are confused about what the Church teaches regarding the tragic reality of suicide.

While we hold that all life is sacred, we are also all too aware that psychological, emotional, and even physical illness — as well as extreme anxiety, fear, and abuse — can lead individuals to take their own lives.

"Although suicide is always objectively sinful, one should not despair of the eternal salvation of persons who have taken their own lives. By ways known to him alone, God can provide the opportunity for salutary repentance. The Church prays for persons who have taken their own lives" (pg. 294). The text also states the reality of illness or other extreme influences can "diminish the responsibility of one committing suicide" (pg. 293). Parishes and grief support groups should show special care and concern for those families that have lost a loved one to suicide. And communities should always try to be mindful of those who might be at risk of suicide or self-harm.

## Protecting God's Children \*Attention Volunteers

The Archdiocese of Detroit has updated its Safe Environment policies. For compliance, adherence to these policies is required in every office, parish, school, and Catholic agency within the AOD to protect especially – children and vulnerable adults from sexual abuse. Requiring all volunteers and employees to take the training empowers more men and women to know the warning signs and helps them become part of the solution of preventing abuse. Running background checks for ALL employees and volunteers can help deter criminals and sexual predators from participating in any parish or school ministry or event. If a criminal understands that they will have to undergo a background check, they will be less likely to attempt to volunteer.

The AOD uses Virtus, an online platform for all training, monitoring, and data collection.

Recertification is required for all existing volunteers and employees who completed Protecting God's Children before January 1, 2020.

\*Recertification must be completed by November 1, 2023

\*Do not create a new account if you have previously taken Protecting God's Children in the past.
