#### A Word From Your Pastor

Dear Parishioners:

The Presence of Jesus is Real in our lives. This Presence is unique. It is a Person, a Divine Person, Who has taken on our human nature so that we may relate to Him. In order to enter into this Relationship, we have to be willing to give all we are and all we have to Him. This is not because He wants to take anything from us, but exactly the contrary, He wants to give us His All, All that He IS and All that He has. In order for us to receive what is offered, He needs all the room we have in our persons. His divinity is offered to our humanity. In the Incarnation and in His Passion, He has laid claim to every aspect of our being. Now, He offers us His Being. We are invited to live divine life humanly, as He did and as He does.




The uniqueness of the Presence of Jesus to us has two aspects that we cannot hold together in our own minds. He is beyond us, invisible, immortal, utterly holy. He makes this aspect present to us in the Sacramental Life of the Church, especially the Eucharist. The second aspect is that He is in us. We experience Jesus in our midst, both inside us and among us, when we open to that Presence. Jesus looks at us from His Place at the right hand of the Father in the fullness of life, human and divine, that belongs to Him in virtue of Who He IS and of His Resurrection. And, He looks at the world around us now through our eyes. When others look at us, they are meant to see Him, just as when we see Him, we see the Father.

As soon as our eyes are opened to see this truth, the truth of the Resurrection at work in us, we see Him and then we no longer see Him, and then we become conscious that He is with us, in us and among us, and that through us He is ready to go out to all the world.

Do you understand? If you begin to understand, then stand on this and go out. Let the Joy of Easter invade your life and through you enter the world. We are invited by the Risen Lord Himself to celebrate Easter by taking Him with us on the way and discovering Him in the Breaking of the Bread.

Our Second Graders are preparing to experience the Holy Eucharist through their First Holy Communion – at St. Mary's in Chillicothe next weekend and at St. Peter's the following weekend. Let us renew our Faith in the Lord's Eucharistic Presence among us.

As we have joyfully seen the Mass attendance increasing at the Sunday Mass, I thought a quick reminder of our seating arrangement may be helpful. In order to maintain distance between households, we use alternate ends of each pew. There is green tape marking the end of the pew available to sit. You should sit with green tape directly in front of you. A few pews are usually filled all the way across, and, therefore, the pews directly in front and behind these full pews must be skipped. If you see a pew is filled all the way across, we invite you to maintain distance by not sitting in the pew in front or behind the full pew, even if it is marked green. At the Triduum and Easter Masses, overflow seating will be available in the church hall.


