COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

A Book is set up at the front of the church for parishioners to write in the names of their departed loved ones. We encourage everyone to come up before Mass or after Mass and write in the names of their loved ones that have passed on. This book will be available for the whole month of November.

<u>November 15, 2020</u> – Among other lessons, today's parable reinforces the importance of every action in the life of discipleship. The small tasks of care and love that we do (or neglect to do) every day are what make up the life of faith. In Jesus' own life, the majority of his time on the earth was spent not in active ministry, but as a "carpenter's son" in Nazareth. For thirty years our Lord's life revolved around his family, community, and his work. We could say that in his hidden life in Nazareth, Jesus redeemed and glorified the everyday events and happenings of human existence. Though we don't have many gospel accounts of Jesus' early years meditating on them can lead us to greater faithfulness in "small matters" and help us to see how every action, no matter how mundane, can be a way of worshiping God.

November 22, 2020 – Today we celebrate **Christ the King**, our final Sunday of the church year and, fittingly, our gospel speaks to us of what will happen at the end of time "when the Son of Man comes in his glory," he will sit in judgment of the nations, and if we were wondering how we will be judged, Jesus spells it out. Those who enter into the kingdom of heaven will be the ones who fed the hungry, gave water to the thirsty, welcomed the stranger, clothed the naked, cared for the ill, and visited the imprisoned. When we show love and care for others, we are loving and caring for Christ, and when we insulate ourselves from suffering and turn away, we are rejecting Christ.

In the golden rule, Jesus tells us we must care for our neighbour as ourselves. Today this commandment is expanded: we are to care for those in need as we would care for the Lord himself. For whether we are serving another or turning our gaze and walking away, we are comforting or rejecting the Lord.
