

Fifth Grade News

Happy Spring! Flowers are in bloom and our bare branches of native trees are showing signs of life. The birds' songs are getting louder as they work to defend their territories and work on building their nests. We see many more Insects as they are awakening from their winter slumber. It is hard to believe that it is already the end of April. Both the students and myself cannot believe how fast this school year is going by.

The fifth graders were very busy during the Lenten Season. They made prayer blankets and dioramas of Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. We finished learning about the sacraments and how to make good moral decisions by using our conscience. The Catholic Church teaches that our conscience is present in our heart. We listen to our conscience as we listen to God to help us make good decisions. The seventh graders are learning more about Jesus of Nazareth as the Servant of God who suffered for our sins. His compassion and mercy brought both physical and spiritual healing.

In science, the fifth grade class finished studying about stars and galaxies and the solar system. The sixth grade class is learning how fronts affect our weather and how weather is predicted using different weather instruments. The seventh graders are currently studying the body systems for the remainder of the school year. The eighth grade class just finished a chapter on energy and heat. The science classes are using interactive notebooks and digital station labs to help with their understanding of the subjects they are learning about.

The 5-6 grade will be attending Camp Tamarack in Ortonville from April 30-May 2. Please keep them in your prayers. Teamwork is a large part of the camp experience. Students will have the opportunity to participate in many outdoor "hands-on" experiences in this camp setting. On May 19, the 5-6 grade students will be visiting the Raisin River National Battlefield Park to learn about the War of 1812. They will be participating in many different activities that occurred during this time period.

As we get closer to the end of our school year, it is important to remember to continue working hard to keep up on our studies. God Bless.


